Dear Friends,

Our parishes are holding the Jesus in the Eucharist gatherings again for this Eucharist Revival. We hope to find hosts to show the study in their homes, inviting their relatives and friends to small groups to do the study and faith sharing together. We have several people who are willing to help you get the group started and show you how simple it is.

The diocese has a unique prayer presence giving us encouragement and sacrificial witness for our Revival. Bishop Peter is currently undergoing treatment for esophageal cancer. Many of you know that a course of treatment of chemo (and immunotherapy) is tailored to each cancer and each patient. Our Bishop is fighting his cancer and offering his sufferings as an oblation, a willing offering, to the Lord for the renewal of the Church in Eucharistic Faith and of every member of his flock to receive the Lord more intimately and fruitfully.

While Bishop Muhich can delegate his Vicars, staff, and priests to do many of his usual duties, I submit that one thing must fall on us as our own responsibility. Let us continue to remember him every day in our prayer for his healing, his spiritual well-being, and to receive the fruits of his prayer sacrifice that we deepen our faith and widen our desire to receive our Lord in the Eucharist.

The Church of St. John the Evangelist is currently putting together a spiritual bouquet to send Bishop Peter. These flowers may include prayer commitments, mass offerings, good works done in his name, devotions, or personal goals accomplished in his honor. We will forward these intentions to him with a card in the near future.

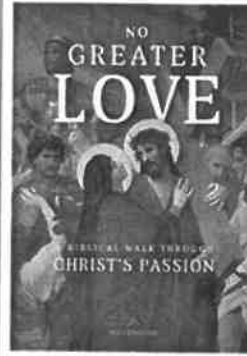
