## **== Fr. Kerry's Korner ==**

Dear Friends,

This is the Solemnity of the Epiphany of the Lord. In many Catholic countries, this is the time for the exchange of gifts. It is also the time when the light born into the world was made manifest to the Nations. Epiphany means to be made manifest, revealed, announced to the mind and the heart. The long journey of the wise men was a journey that took purpose, strength and heart. Yet they made a dangerous pilgrimage led by awe and wonder, curiosity in their science, or intrigued by a nascent faith to discover the meaning of a new star's appearance.

They came bearing gifts. The gifts were symbolic then of the baby's future role as priest, prophet, and king. And they remain a profound gift of faith for us today as we prayed in the prayer over the gifts in Mass, "Look with favor, Lord, we pray, on these gifts of your Church, in which are offered now not gold or frankincense or myrrh, but he who by them is proclaimed, sacrificed and received, Jesus Christ".

This Sunday, manifest to us is Jesus the Lord! We receive him so we may be a blessing for others. The wise men continued their journey home. Lightened by their gifts and unburdened by the generosity of the same, what lightness of being, memory of glory, or wonder in mystery did they carry away with them to share at home?

Today we have been blessed. The awe-inspiring stories from Scripture bless and challenge our imagination. Think how you will share your blessing using these words by Fr. Ron Rohlheiser to guide you: "To bless another person is to give away some of one's own life so that the other might be more resourced for his or her journey. Good parents do that for their children. Good teachers do that for their students, good mentors do that for their protégés, good pastors do that for their parishioners, good politicians do that for their countries, and good elders do that for the young. They give away some of their own lives to resource the other. The wise men did that for Jesus".

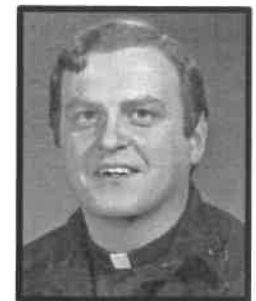
