

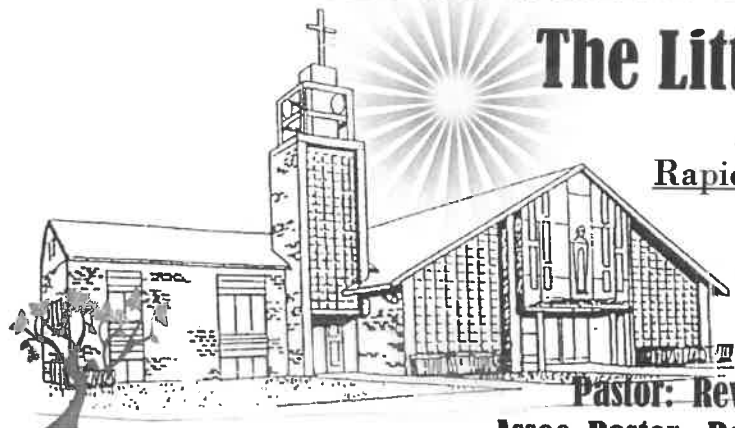

## == Deacon Chuck's Chat ==

### MY CALLING TO THE DIACONATE

I wish I could relate some dramatic story about my being called to the diaconate, some great conversion experience, or a visit from the Archangel Gabriel, but that's not how it happened. Many years before I gave the diaconate serious consideration, I simply had the desire to serve Jesus in a more active way than simply attending Sunday Mass and teaching my young children some basic prayers.

My first step toward being a mature Catholic was probably becoming a Knight of Columbus. My dad brought me into the Knights when I was about 20 years old. Helping with activities the Knights had such as the Tootsie Roll Drive and pancake breakfasts helped me to feel useful and gave me a sense of ownership of my Catholic faith. Most of my early K of C activities started for me when I lived in Ortonville, Minnesota.

In my mid 30's, I was asked to teach CCD, teaching 6<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup> graders about our faith for several years. At the age of 35, I purchased my dad's business and life changed dramatically for me and my family. We moved to Rapid City from Ortonville, MN, and I became very busy learning and managing the business. Although I was still involved in the church, my activities did decrease some.

It was in my early 40s that the idea of becoming a deacon first seriously came to me. I put it off thinking I was too busy with work and family to pursue that calling at that time. I believe for me, that was the right decision. I do remember Bishop Chaput visiting with me after one of his First Friday meetings that he held when he was our Bishop here in Rapid City. He asked if I was interested in considering the diaconate and then stopped himself and said, "Don't do it now if you're too busy, wait for your life to settle some."

As the next several years went by, the thought of becoming a deacon would resurface on a regular basis. The kids grew to the age of being able to take care of themselves and things did "settle" as the Bishop suggested. As I reached my early 50's, I realized that I needed to find out if this was a calling from God and to move on if it was, or soon I would be too old to really make a real contribution in the ministry. And so, the process started with a call to Fr. George Wittenberg who oversaw the diaconate program for our diocese. I remember often asking God if He really wanted me to be a deacon, and I always received a resounding "Yes!" in my mind each time.

The process started with a year of prayer and discernment with the guidance of the diaconate team. The process of becoming a deacon took seven years for me. This is a year longer than the usual six years, but for me, that was what was needed. I was ordained a deacon on May 29, 2014. All in all, it has been a wonderful trip for me. I hope I have been a help to our parish over the years. Although I know that I am slowing down now, as old age is beginning to take over, I still hope to be a help to our church for several years to come.
