## == *Fr. Kerry's Korner* ==

*This week's Korner is from our Summer Seminarian, Jesse Willis*

Happy July to all of you at St. Therese. I am excited to be spending this month with you and learning as much as I can about parish life and pastoral ministry. My name is Jesse Willis. I am a first-year theologian at Kenrick-Glennon Seminary studying for the Diocese of Rapid City. I grew up in Wall, SD, with my mother and older brother and graduated from Wall High School in 2012. After high school, I attended Black Hills State University in Spearfish, SD, where I received my B.S. in Biology and Chemistry. For hobbies I enjoy riding my longboard, golfing, and lifting weights.

My journey to seminary started when I was about 18 years old. A seminarian for the Diocese at the time told me that every man should consider his vocation. I kept running away from the Lord's call trying to find fulfillment in school and work. One day, I was on my lunch break thinking about my life and realizing that this was not something I wanted to do my whole life. I also realized that four years had passed since I first started to think about seminary and so I decided that it was time to go. Shortly after, I applied, and my Bishop sent me to St. Louis.

Just this last week I was graced to accompany some of the high school students from St. Therese to a Youth Catholic conference in Denver called Steubenville. During the three days of this conference the youth of our Diocese were able to have generous access to the Sacrament of Reconciliation, listen to renowned Catholic speakers, and spend time with Jesus in Adoration. A time that was truly grace filled. For me, the biggest grace was found on the bus ride home. About an hour outside of Rapid City, there was an opportunity to listen to the graces that were experienced by the young men and women who attended. Although all of them were wonderful, there were two that stuck out to me. In my small group that I oversaw, there were two older boys who had been to Steubenville multiple times before. I was impressed by their testimony and how selfless their desires were. Both had received so much from Steubenville conferences in the past and this time were no longer concerned about receiving more for themselves, but instead, how they could help foster an encounter with Jesus to those who had never been before. They found profound joy in the service of others. In that moment I was proud to say they were in my small group.

I am looking forward to meeting all of you throughout the month of July and building relationships that will last into priesthood. Please do not hesitate to introduce yourself and say hello.

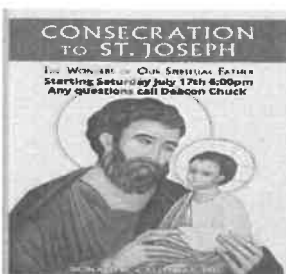
## **ANOTHER LITTLE FUNNY ...**
