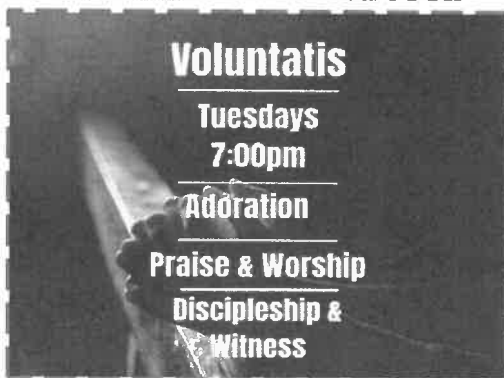

== Fr. Kerry's Korner ==

What a week we have had! While the festivities were muted this time because of health concerns, the ordination and installation of our new bishop was a beautiful and historical point in our diocese. I am so proud of the people of our diocese, our priests and seminarians, who showed the best possible hospitality to the bishops and priests, and the family of Bishop Muhich.

The seminarians, Josh and Josiah, and I entertained two other visitors last Monday and Tuesday. Monday evening two missionaries showed up at the rectory door to share their faith and the message that God loves us and accepts us just as we are, and a special message for priests that "you are needed, you are not non-essential."

They came back not long after visiting with me to huddle under the entrance to the offices for protection from the rain and hail. I was out cleaning my garage, de-cluttering, and organizing so I asked them to help me. After I was hot, sweaty, and thirsty, the gospel from last week in Matthew 11 came to mind, "if anyone gives even a cold drink of water to one of these little ones because he is a disciple of mine, will surely not go without his reward." We invited missionaries Tim and Dan, Catholics from Denver, to stay the night. I fed them and the seminarians prepared room for them in the little exercise room. While we are not waiting on our reward, we were certainly blessed by their witness.

They came without extra clothing, money, mobile phone (no way to contact their families) and no plans for places to stay while they are here for the week. They literally follow the command of Jesus to the seventy-two disciples to go out two by two. Our household will not forget the faith and dedication of these two men. They remind me of how powerful it is that we tell our own story, give witness to what God in his mercy has done for us.

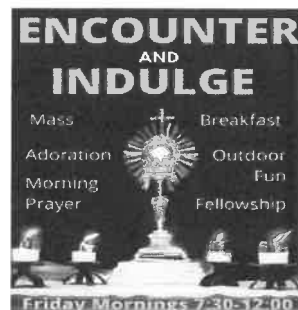
