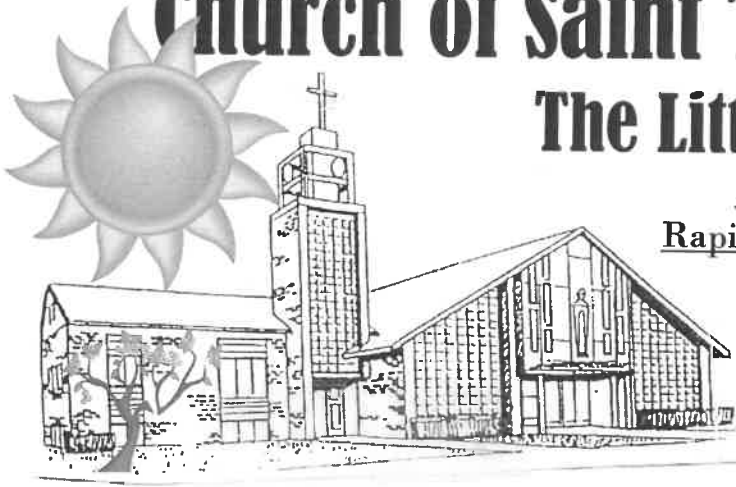

YEAR OF THE EUCHARIST

We gather on Sunday to worship God the Father through Jesus in the power of the Holy Spirit. The celebration of the Mass is first an act of worship and at the heart of this worship is Christ's sacrifice made present in an unbloody way. Through participation, we are drawn into an encounter with Jesus who is present to us in the whole Mass. We join Him in this offering of himself to the Father. In this sacrifice, Jesus is both the priest and the victim, and offers himself through the priest, who through his ordination stands in the person of Christ. In other words, the Mass is a representation of Jesus' sacrifice on Calvary offered to God the Father. We are united to this sacrifice when we fully, actively and consciously participate in the Mass through our attentive listening as well as our spoken and sung prayer. Uniting ourselves to Jesus allow us to encounter Him in the Sacred Scripture, in the priest, in one another and most importantly in his Body and Blood given to us in Holy Communion.

== Fr. Kerry's Korner ==

"You shall love the Lord, your God, with all your heart, with all your being, with all your strength, and with all your mind, and your neighbor as yourself."

The young scholar of the law knew very well the ancient **shema** of Israel for it was recited daily by everyone, as common as the Lord's Prayer. It was so frequently on the lips of the Jews that they might always remember God's tender and covenanted love for them. They were chosen by God and they chose to remember these words and pass them on to their children.

We too, are called by God into the covenant of Christ's body and blood. We are called and chosen forever to remember Him until he comes again. Being fed by the Lord, with his own Body, his own Blood is a powerful sign of God's commitment to us. Therefore, whenever we pray in the presence of the Eucharist or pray attentively in Mass we are encountering Jesus.

Fr. Pedro Arrupe, SJ, once superior general of the Jesuits, said the person who prays well, falls in love with God and it decides everything. He said: "Nothing is more practical than finding God, that is, than falling in a love in a quite absolute, final way. What you are in love with, what seizes your imagination will affect everything. It will decide what will get you out of bed in the mornings, what you will do with your evenings, how you spend your weekends, what you read, who you know, what breaks your heart, and what amazes you with joy and gratitude. Fall in love, stay in love, and it will decide everything."

Let's give ourselves that time with the Lord.
