One sentence sure to make us tremble or laugh, "I'm from Washington and I am here to help." I think we have all come across situations when we did not understand or appreciate a rule, custom, or code. With the parking lot finished, I have heard some pretty good comments about the extra parking, as well as some incredulous comments. Everyone seems to like the extra parking space, the trees, and the plantings. Thank you to everyone who made a special donation for the landscaping. I also want to thank Scott and Travis Sime of Jolly Lane for planting everything. The two landscaping pods in the parking lot are a beautiful addition, even if we would have preferred to forgo the expense. I think the trees and landscaping pods are wonderful. They were also required by the City for new parking lot construction.

When we wanted to add to the parking lot, we had to re-apply for a conditional use permit for parking in our residential area. The process exists to ensure that businesses or dwellings that are higher density will not negatively impact the residents. Any new construction must be done to current codes if it hopes to be approved by the city. If you look around town you will see trees and plantings done around buildings and parking lots (would that they were all maintained.) There is also a rule, as a safety requirement, that no parking space may open directly to an alley. Thus you see four spots crossed out by white lines and concrete parking berms in the new area. Fortunately the City allowed us to "grandfather in" the long line of handicapped parking spots on our alley. Our engineers did a great job guiding us through the code requirements, approval process, and site design to maximize parking.

Which brings me to the one code requirement that doesn't really make much sense. We left one garage standing from the 832 Dilger purchase. We are now required to label it 611 Van Buren. We needed two handicapped parking spots up there even though they don't serve our purposes well. I can only say that we use all our handicapped parking at most weekend services and it is really appreciated. We thought it prudent not to argue those two spaces which would require going through an approval process again, in favor of the concessions on our current parking spots which open to the alley. I will occasionally use a handicapped spot farther from the entrance during the day when there are no services for short term parking. I think it would be permissible to use those spots at the north end of our lot for any purpose if we are very close to Mass time and they haven't been accessed yet. Please err on the side of generosity in your prudential judgements. Thank you for your special donations to the parking lot project.
