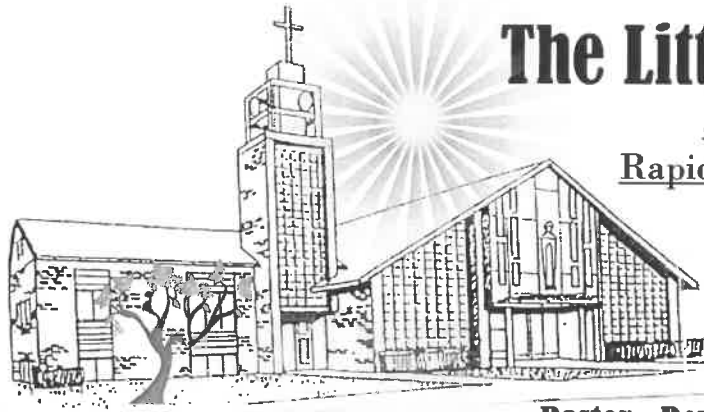

Friends,

Summer is flying by, in my opinion, and sometimes, even on vacation, we can forget to recreate. New experiences, foreign lands, reunions, and the outdoors can be recreational if we remember rest and reflection. In the Gospel of Mark, above, Jesus invites the apostles, recently returned from their mission of preaching, healing, and driving out demons to come to a place of rest. Perhaps He is revealing they have a need they did not comprehend. The success of their mission was heady stuff. They were on a high with the results of their efforts. At that time precisely, Jesus tells them to come away from everything to take care of themselves.

Vacation time, time away, a slower pace, may add up to recreation, feeding our souls, caring for our bodies, enriching our minds, but it does not guarantee it. Likewise, Jesus certainly didn't take vacations in the sense we imagine. He is instructing his apostles, and leading by example, to make time for themselves: rest, nourishment, prayer, family, so they may remain strong for their work every day. Prayer, they would learn, is the source of strength, creativity, joy, and vision.

The apostles would learn to fill their cup before they offered it to others. Jesus did the same, frequently going to an out of the way place by himself to be with the Father. When we pray daily, we have access in the one Spirit to our Father. Jesus calls us to that intimacy and we choose to embrace it through prayer. We choose to spend time with good friends and family to maintain bonds of love. We marvel in creation in the outdoors, sightseeing, or working our hobbies. We are people of many dimensions, and we feed the whole person, not once a year, but through good discipline and good ordering of our time.
