== Fr. Kerry's Korner ==

"You shall love the Lord, your God, with all your heart, with all your being, with all your strength, and with all your mind, and your neighbor as yourself."

The young scholar of the law knew very well the ancient shema of Israel for it was recited daily by everyone, as common as the Lord's Prayer. It was so frequently on the lips of the Jews that they might always remember God's tender and covenanted love for them. They were chosen by God and they chose to remember these words and pass them on to their children.

We too, are called by God into the covenant of Christ's body and blood. We are called and chosen forever to remember Him until he comes again. Being fed by the Lord, with his own Body, his own Blood is a powerful sign of God's commitment to us.

Therefore, whenever we pray in the presence of the Eucharist or pray attentively in Mass we are encountering Jesus.

Fr. Pedro Arrupe, SJ, once superior general of the Jesuits, said the person who prays well, falls in love with God and it decides everything. He said: "Nothing is more practical than finding God, that is, than falling in a love in a quite absolute, final way. What you are in love with, what seizes your imagination will affect everything. It will decide what will get you out of bed in the mornings, what you will do with your evenings, how you spend your weekends, what you read, who you know, what breaks your heart, and what amazes you with joy and gratitude. Fall in love, stay in love, and it will decide everything." *Let's give ourselves that time with the Lord.*
