## WANT A ROSE? – TRY THIS!

Ask God to grant me the favor I implore, and tell Him I will love Him each day more and more. This is to be followed by 5 Hail Mary's, 5 Our Father's, 5 Glory Be's. The prayers are to be said by 11 am daily for 5 days.**

## **== Fr. Kerry's Korner ==**

I wrote the following speaking for the priests working in the Diocese and read it at Bishop Gruss's farewell.

In the Summer of 2011, we were waiting for a new bishop to be named, praying for a man who would give us a shepherd's care. Having been ordained 27 years, I had been through the process before and received two very different men, who were exactly what we needed at the time. Therefore, there was little anxiety on my part. I had only two personal prayers: let me have one more bishop who older than me, and please God let him have a last name everyone can pronounce. I was very pleased then to receive a pastor from Davenport, Iowa, Bishop Robert Dwayne Gruss, the 9<sup>th</sup> bishop of Rapid City. A German lady in the diocese explained to me that Pope Benedict had given us a gift. Your name in German means greeting. But she explained when you give a **gruss** to someone it is more than a greeting, but a gift of yourself. Your gifts, Bishop would soon be revealed. The following year in your first homily to the Diocese at Chrism Mass, you turned to the priests and addressed us, "My brothers and sons . . ." In that greeting I was deeply moved in my heart and saw what you would become for our diocese: courageous shepherd, visionary leader, a master of disciples, a concerned father for your priests. Your work with the priests and deacons, benefitting from your formation experience and personal prayer life, encouraged us to enter more deeply into the mystery of Christ's love in the heart of the Father. Your assistance finding good retreat directors and spiritual directors for us has helped us immensely. You have encouraged us in ongoing formation and professional development, and challenged us to be spiritual physicians, men after Christ's own heart. And you leave us, priests and people, better formed to be intentional disciples, a diocese with a defined mission. As you leave us to go to Saganaw, we send you with a **gruss**, a good wish from the heart, more than a farewell greeting. Bishop go joyfully, boldly and lovingly, with our gratitude and affection, give your new people, and your brothers and sons, a shepherd's care. Your portrait will remain here in our new pastoral center! Your disciples will remain in each parish engaged in ministry, your intentional legacy in the Diocese of Rapid City.
