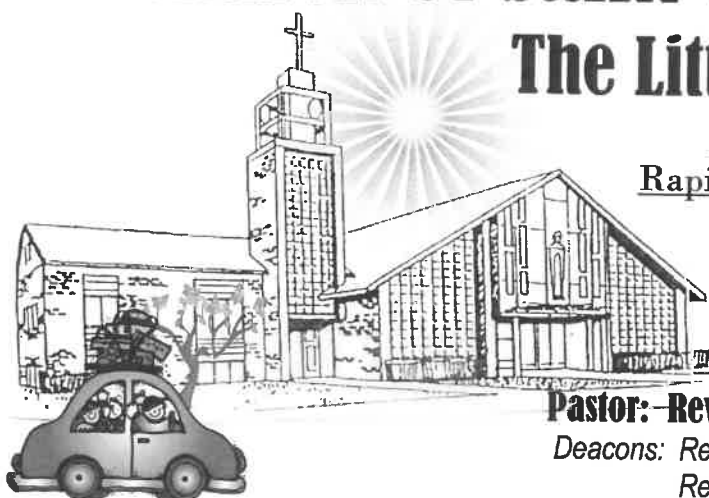

Faithful Citizenship Principles for USCCB Investments

Introduction The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB, Conference) is called to exercise faithful, competent and socially responsible stewardship in how it manages its financial resources. As a Catholic organization, the Conference draws the values, directions and criteria which guide its financial choices from the Gospel, universal church teaching and Conference statements. In order to function effectively and to carry out its mission, the Conference depends on a reasonable return on its investments and is required to operate in a fiscally sound, responsible and accountable manner. == Fr. Kerry's Korner ==

Dear Friends,

One day St. Teresa of Avila heard someone say: "If only I had lived at the time of Jesus... If only I had seen Jesus... If only I had talked with Jesus..." To this she responded: "But do we not have in the Eucharist the living, true and real Jesus present before us? Why look for more?" She referred to the Eucharistic Real Presence in the tabernacles of our Churches. With faith, and the sacraments of the Church, Christ is present, active, and engaging us in real encounters with his loving heart every day. Long before Teresa lived in the sixteenth century, the Church recognized the value of praying before the Blessed Sacrament.

Daily Mass is also an excellent way to begin the day. For people who have time in the morning for prayer and contemplation, being daily fed along with the community of believers who come to meditate on the Word in the liturgy, receiving the Body and Blood of Christ in the Eucharist, gives us grace each day to increase our faith, hope, and charity. St. Damian of Molokai, the leper priest, said, "Were it not for the constant presence of our divine Master in our humble chapel, I would not have found it possible to persevere in sharing the lot of the lepers in Molokai... The Eucharist is the bread that gives strength... It is at once the most eloquent proof of His love and the most powerful means of fostering His love in us. He gives Himself every day so that our hearts as burning coals may set afire the hearts of the faithful."

How many times have we wondered if we would have the strength to remain faithful to our daily duties but not thought to ask for our daily bread. Morning Mass, following immediately after my morning prayer time reminds me that I am never alone in my struggles or accomplishments. Jesus is our strength and consolation. I once heard Fr. Benedict Groeschel say that adoration of the Blessed Sacrament is one of the most missionary practices we do. I have lost his words on this subject, but our patron, Therese the Little Flower said this about praying before the Eucharist (and probably influenced Fr. Groeschel), "God does not despise these hidden struggles with our selves, so much richer in merit because they are unseen: 'The patient man is better than the valiant and he that ruleth his spirit than he that taketh cities.' (Prov. xvi. 32). By our little acts of charity practiced in the shade we convert souls far away, we help missionaries, we win for them abundant alms, and by that means build actual dwellings both spiritual and materials for our Eucharistic Lord."

I invite you to consider our morning Mass here at 7:30 am, our weekly Adoration Holy Hour and Morning Prayer on Fridays at 8:00 am, and the practice of making a visit before the Blessed Sacrament anytime you have a few minutes throughout your day. I also encourage us to take part in the Diocesan wide Perpetual Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament at the Cathedral. You may sign up using this link:

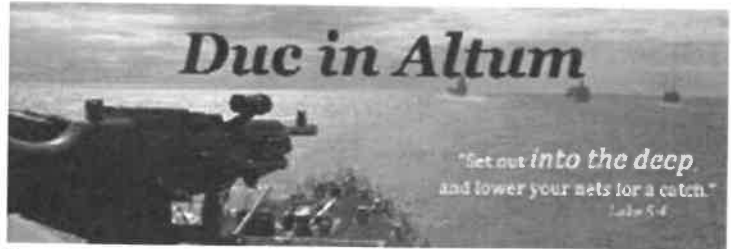
