== Fr. Kerry's Korner ==

Dear Friends,

It is parable time again! Jesus teaches us with stories that draw us in and let us dwell in our thoughts. His way of teaching requires us to imagine during the story, and we let our imagination question, wonder, and inquire. By the end of the story, we may be filling in details that the teacher didn't offer. We may learn from our questions what we really desire. The parable may expose our fears or release our confidence.

"Master, did you not sow good seed in your field? Where have the weeds come from?" He answered, "An enemy has done this." We ask "Who is the enemy?" Weeds come from everywhere. They are borne on the winds, deposited by birds, left from the previous season's detritus. Pogo the Possum puns on a famous saying of Captain Perry, "We have met the enemy, and he is us." What we think may be ours, a great naval victory, or a skill we possess may in fact have a different origin. Peace of mind may have its origin in laxity or ignorance. What we think of as good enough may, in fact, be impressed on us by a bad spirit rather than the good and generous spirit. These are the weeds the enemy has sown in our good garden.

While we can grow up along with the weeds, faults, vices, bad habits, lack of zeal for the Lord, we grow better and are more productive if we prune back or gently let the Spirit of repentance and the Lord of Love begin to direct us to new freedom and a generous harvest.

**Then the righteous will shine like the sun
in the kingdom of their Father.**

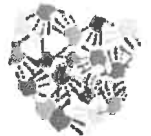
