== Fr. Kerry's Korner ==

Four years ago our Holy Father Francis made the memorial of St. Mary Magdalene on July 22 in the Church calendar a



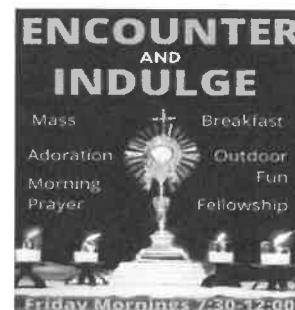
Feast, upgrading it from a Memorial. I am sure you noticed the change! For the liturgy it means we do the Gloria with the Mass, but for the Church it signals Francis' desire to highlight her contribution to the Church of the Apostles. She has been sometimes referred to as a prostitute, but there is no real reason to infer that from Scripture. She was a sinner, yes, but redeemed by knowing and following Jesus.

Francis points out that she was, and is, remembered for being the apostle to the Apostles, for having announced to them, "I have seen the [risen] Lord." She also was the one to remain with Mary at the foot of the Cross when the Apostles had fled. For these reasons she was part of the Apostles company and an important member of the early church. That is cause for rejoicing. When she saw Jesus after the resurrection, she went to embrace him, but Jesus said to not hold on to him, but rather go and tell your brothers what you have seen. As we can see in the art piece above, she may also help us in our social distancing!
