

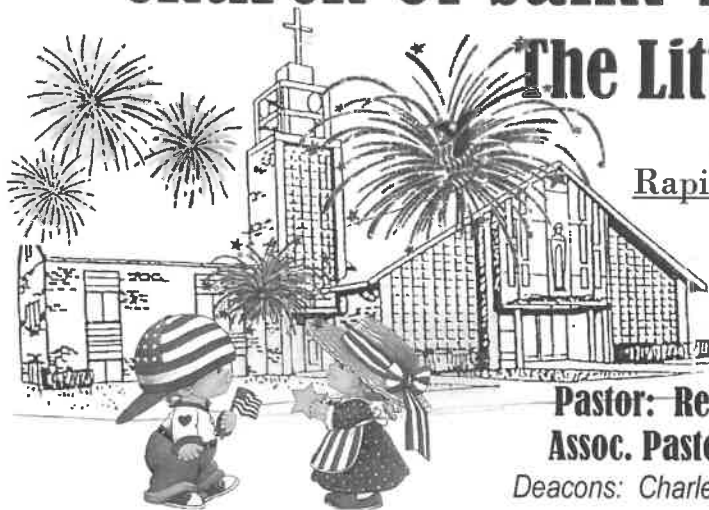

Dear Friends,

The Bishops of South Dakota, on the anniversary of the Supreme court Dobbs decision striking down abortion on demand, have issued a Pastoral Letter, Bearing the Face of Jesus, urging all South Dakotans to continue to work for the dignity of the unborn and their safety in the womb. The bishops note that the Constitution for the State declares, "No person shall be deprived of life, liberty, or property, without due process of law." The proposed constitutional amendment circulating would permit abortion in late stages on babies viable outside the womb, and even abortion for purposes of sex selection, would make the Constitution a self-contradictory document.

You may access this statement on the Diocesan website. We will have copies available and be able to email the document to you upon request. It is a beautiful reiteration of Catholic Teaching on the dignity of human life and well worth reading. Working together all South Dakotans may develop a strong solidarity reflective of God's desire for unity among all Christian people.

This week we will celebrate Independence Day! I will be leaving on vacation and will return on the 14th of July. Fr. Michael will be busy and will welcome your prayers and support. I will be driving west and bicycling the Rails to Trails offerings in Wyoming, Idaho, Washington, and Montana. I will be visiting my family along the road and return with a great sunburn.

I will celebrate Independence Day by praying for our country and listening to a good book again, The Supremes Greatest Hits: the 34 Court Cases that Most Directly Affect Your Life by Michael Trachtman. I think there is a second edition covering 44 cases now. I pray you all have good family time and safe travel for the holiday.
