Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,
The people of Africa are joyous and faith-filled, but they also often face challenges due to poverty, the high incidence of disease, food shortages, and migration. The Church in Africa supports pastoral projects that foster lasting peace and reconciliation in a continent often marked by division and tension.
