Faithful Citizenship "A hundred years ago, on 6 July 1902, Maria Goretti died in the hospital at Nettuno, brutally stabbed the day before in the little village of Le Ferriere, in the Pontine Marshes. Her spiritual life, the strength of her faith, her ability to forgive her murderer have placed her among the best-loved saints of the 20th century. ... St. Maria Goretti was a girl whom God's Spirit endowed with the courage to stay faithful to her Christian vocation even to the point of making the supreme sacrifice of her life. ... In the heart of the night we can feel frightened and insecure, and we impatiently await the coming of the light of dawn. Dear young people, it is up to you to be the watchmen of the morning (cf. --- Notes From Father Bill ---

Due to the financial generosity of YOU and due to the increased members of young people in the parish, both the Parish Council and Financial Council have interviewed and hired two people. One will be the **Religious Education Coordinator**. The function of this position is to coordinate the religious education program of pre-school through the 5th grade. Summer work includes recruiting and ordering materials for fall and coordinating the Vacation Bible School activities. **Kathy Haselhorst** was selected for that position. 10+ hours per week is the average time for that position.

The other position is the full-time, 40 hours, **Coordinator of Youth Ministry**. The coordinator will ensure that all components of Youth Ministry, specifically those of word, worship and creating community are being developed in the Youth Ministry Program. The coordinator is to oversee and coordinate the Birth-to-30 Youth Ministry Program. Grades 6 thru 12 will be the primary grades for the coordinator. **Randy Vette** has been selected to fulfill that position.

Many people applied for both of these positions and I want to thank them and both of the Councils for their selection of Kathy & Randy.

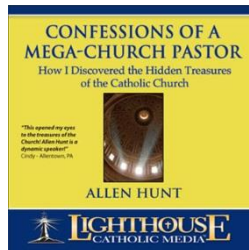

Veritatis Splendor Institute

This fall, the diocese will begin a new diocesan program of certification for catechists, the *Veritatis Splendor Institute* (VSI), named for Bl. Pope John Paul II's great encyclical, *The Splendor of Truth*. The goal of the VSI is the mission of the Church, that of proclaiming the Gospel to all people, and bringing people to a deeper encounter with Jesus Christ. This program will be an opportunity to grow as evangelists and teachers. The VSI will provide courses of instruction in the content of the Faith, catechetical methodology, classroom management, and courses for particular apostolates or ministries: youth ministry, RCIA, liturgy, music, retreats, adult education, children's catechesis, and more! The program will also offer formation in prayer, spirituality, and discipleship. The VSI will offer a Basic Level Certification (one-year program), and a Master Level Certification (two-year program, following after completion of Basic Certification), with courses offered once a month on Saturdays. If you are interested in this program of catechist certification, you can request an Information Packet with Application Form from your pastor, or from the Office of Faith Formation (ssafford@dioc.org, 605-716-5214 x230).
