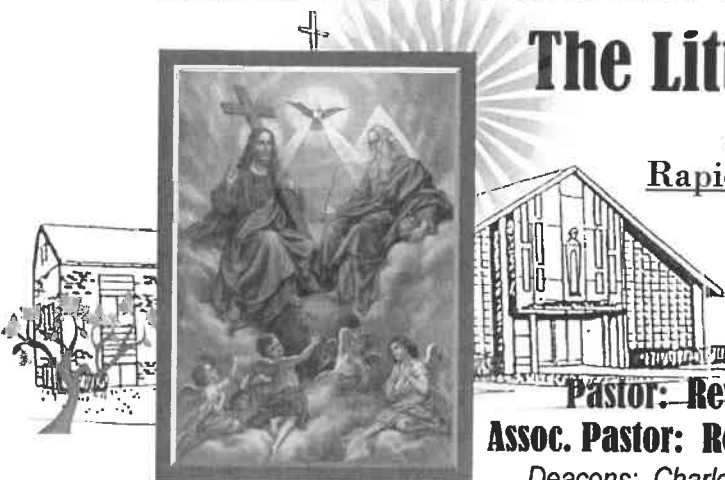

== Fr. Kerry's Korner ==

Dear Friends,

On the 19th of June, the Diocese of Rapid City, along with the dioceses of our nation, will begin the National Eucharistic Revival. Plans are being made for a three-year process leading to a way of life and understanding of the Eucharist in the Life of the Church. Sunday the 19th, St. Therese will cancel our afternoon Mass at 5:30, so we may all participate in the Mass at 3 pm at the Cathedral of OLPH, followed by a Eucharistic Procession to the Bandshell at Memorial Park by the Monument <https://www.rapidcitydiocese.org/revival/>

The Procession is a liturgical act related to our procession to receive the Eucharist in Mass. It takes the act of receiving and translates it into the living of our Eucharist. When we bring the monstrance with the Eucharistic Lord in procession, we are demonstrating our desire to take Jesus to the public square and give his teaching, compassion and mercy to the community.

“Theologically, processions remind us that we are pilgrims journeying through this earthly existence following Jesus on “the Way” (an early title for the Church). In the Eucharistic procession on the solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi) we publicly proclaim this truth, following the Lord physically even as we pledge anew to do so spiritually. We also give public witness to our acceptance of the Lord’s words: “The bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world” (Jn 6:51). As such, public processions serve as tools of evangelization within our neighborhoods,” writes Msgr. William King.

The link above to the Diocese includes a rsvp to give them an idea of the number coming for the picnic in Memorial Park. You can always just come. It also says there will be bussing to the Immaculate Conception Church so you may do a shorter procession, and rides back to the Cathedral after the event. Please check out the Diocesan website and our bulletin announcement for more information.

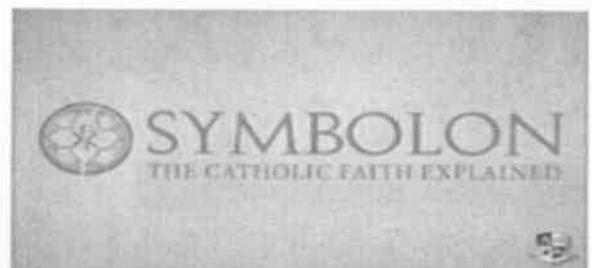
