## **== Fr. Kerry's Korner ==**

Dear friends,

With the recent losses of long-time parishioners of our parish and some friends, and with Memorial Day still fresh in my mind, I have been thinking of parents and grandparents who have died; the last, my Dad Mickey, who passed in 2009. Last Thursday was the anniversary of death of my Mom Corinne Oase Prendiville. She died a day short of her 52<sup>nd</sup> birthday in 1989 of advanced and undiagnosed heart disease. This week my brother Kelly pointed out that he has lived now, longer without her, than he had with her. For me, it is the same time, 32 years.

Perhaps the deepest part of my grief at that time was the sense that there was so much history and experiences that would never be. Her loss was devastating also in the support I had lost for my vocation. There was a sense that something would always be missing or not quite right again. She understood me better than anyone. Yes, I was a momma's boy, but in a good way. These words of St. Paul became rock for me then, as now: **Brothers and sisters: We are always courageous, although we know that while we are at home in the body we are away from the Lord, for we walk by faith, not by sight.** 2 Cor 5.6

Walking by faith is the way we recover from loss, embrace the future, look for new support systems, and retain our joy in the Lord. Faith and the communion of the saints have kept my relationship with my earthly mother alive in my heart. Faith has helped me live in hope of heaven. Living courageously, we recognize the strength of our friendships and covenants live on past death. Death has no power over us.

Tell the Lord your story in prayer. Ask the Holy Spirit to awaken you and renew you to the gifts that surround you. Ready yourself to walk in faith, hope, and love.
