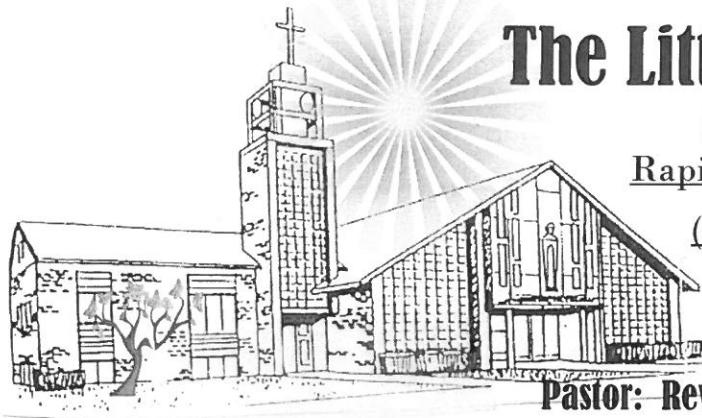

Faithful Citizenship Our Holy Father reminds us of Saint John Paul II's call for a global ecological conversion which not only respects the human person but also concerns itself with the planet's systems of support for its living organisms; a moral conversion is necessary to "take into account the nature of each being and of its mutual connection in an ordered system" (John Paul II, Encyclical Letter *Sollicitudo Rei Socialis*, 1987; "everything is closely interrelated" (LS 137). We may well heed the wisdom of our Lakota brothers and sisters in this respect, repeated in so many ways in *Laudato Si*. (From Fr.
