Faithful Citizenship "A powerful new earthquake struck Nepal on Tuesday (May 12), bringing more damage to this country already devastated by a major quake three weeks ago. When the latest earthquake hit, Catholic Relief Services (CRS) teams were out in the field in the Gorkha district, reaching people in communities damaged in the first quake with relief supplies. ... The latest earthquake, centered about 50 miles east of Nepal's capital Kathmandu, was magnitude 7.3. The April 25 quake registered 7.8. It killed at least 8,000 people. ... CRS, which has committed a minimum of \$10 million to Nepal, plans to reach 15,000 families (75,000 people) with emergency relief in the next few weeks and continue for years in assisting in rebuilding."


