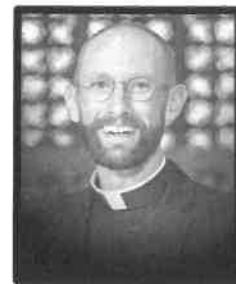

## == Fr. Kerry's Korner ==

*'What do you suppose that I am? I am not he.  
Behold, one is coming after me;  
I am not worthy to unfasten the sandals of his feet.'*

Dear Friends,

The birth of John the Baptist was unusual in several ways. His Mother Elizabeth is described as aged, as was Zachariah, his Father. They had been childless all their lives. Perhaps the event of what Elizabeth felt when Mary, pregnant with Jesus, visited her had been spoken of in the village. And then the naming faux pas and Zachariah's inability to speak happened. "No one in your family has this name," was very unusual for people of a tribe or clan.

"What then will this child be?" is an appropriate response to the mystery of little John's birth and naming ceremony. Parents and family members must ask the same question when one of their own is brought to baptism. High School seniors must get tired of the similar question when graduation approaches. The premise, of course, is we all have a reason for being, a call to follow, a purpose within us. In many ways, and in God's time, this is being revealed to us.

The prophet Isaiah prophesied saying, "Hear me, O coastlands, listen, O distant peoples. The LORD called me from birth, from my mother's womb he gave me my name." His purpose was to bring people back to the Lord, to be a light to guide and lead. Everything spoken of Isaiah we see, in the spiritual sense, applying to the Son of God. What then will this child be? Lord, Savior, Redeemer.

The Birth of the Baptist we solemnly mark this weekend is a point of light showing us the way to Jesus.

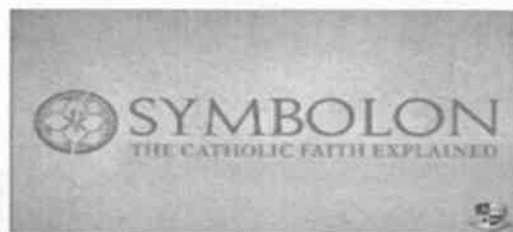


