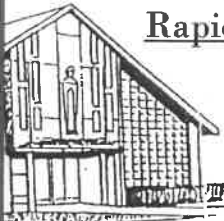
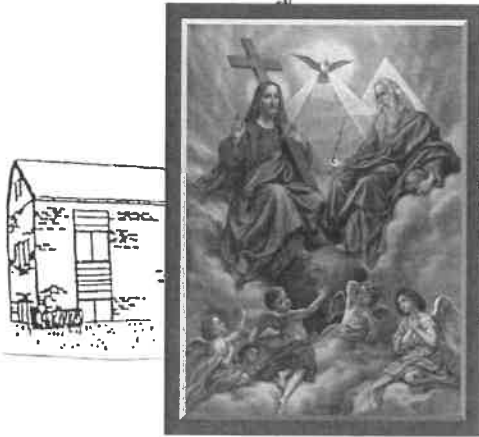

== Fr. Kerry's Korner ==

Dear Friends,

I learned how to do the trick of taking three kitchen matches, putting the heads together and lighting them to illustrate the truth of the Holy Trinity. As the matches burn together, and if you blow them out quickly, they will fuse together (as one). It is surely a limping demonstration for such a central mystery of our faith, but we do try! When the baptized come to the Mass we begin to pray, "In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." From that moment on we are entered into the life of the Trinity, in union with the three persons. We pray with great faith for it is God the Holy Trinity, praying through us. We surrender our self to the living God to become one Body with Christ as our Head.

Before he died, Jesus prayed, "may all be one, as you, Father, are in me and I in you, that they also may be in us, that the world may believe that you sent me" (John 17:21). In his passion, Christ triumphed over evil by reconciling and unifying all humanity. We become one spiritual and mystical Body ready to live and represent the life of the Lord for all people. In a recent column in his Cheyenne Diocesan newspaper, Bishop Steven Biegler said, "...the devil works in direct opposition to Christ, and one of his main goals is to divide us." As Father Lou Cameli said, "The destination of our journey is unity in God, and the way we make the journey is in unity with each other." This explains why the devil is so committed to fostering division" (The Devil You Don't Know, p. 65). We need to be wary of how the devil exploits anger, contempt, and resentment as means to divide us."

The Eucharist, a sacrament of unity, will always be lived with close association with the Sacrament of Penance for its efficacy and fruitfulness. The Eucharistic Revival needs a revival of Confession, of penitent souls seeking greater life and grace. We must remember the words of Jesus counseling us to "go reconcile with our brother before we offer our gift at the altar." The gift we bring when we partake of offering bread and wine, is the totality of our life. We want to offer a gift pleasing to the Lord. Again Bishop Steven, "... it is crucial to recall how Jesus linked liturgical participation and reconciliation. When people have contempt for others due to feuds or political factions, the danger is to accept it as normal. How many people come to Mass harboring anger against someone, yet with no qualms about receiving Holy Communion? Have we lost the sense that it signifies both communion with God and communion with one another?"

Fr. Michael and I want to be available as much as possible for Confession. You should always feel free to ask us for a special time if that is necessary.

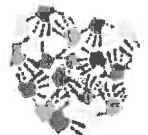
