Fr. Kerry's Korner

Dear friends,

Joan Carroll Cruz wrote a book called *Eucharistic Miracles*. I am sharing a story about a favorite saint, Catherine. Every Eucharist is a miracle in the changing of substance of bread and wine into the Body and Blood of Christ. This miracle is challenged by the other extraordinary part of the miracle, the bread and the wine sustain their original appearance. So much so, that the Eucharist and the receiving of Holy Communion can seem ordinary. Every so often God provides a miracle of the already miraculous Eucharist.

"Several extraordinary receptions of the Eucharist are related in the life of St Catherine of Siena, the Dominican mystic who lived in Italy in the 1300s. One of these took place on the Feast of the Conversion of St Paul.

Weak and exhausted from spiritual trials, St Catherine entered the church of St Dominic, but instead of joining her sisters within the church, she stood in a corner near the door, close to an unused altar. One of the sisters saw her and went over to lead her to the rest of the community when the time came to receive Communion. But when Catherine's turn came, the priest waved her on without giving her a Host. The same thing happened during the two following Masses.

Catherine accepted it as a sign of her unworthiness and went to her pew to continue praying. Unknown to those within the church, the prior of the monastery had given orders to the priests to withhold Communion from the saint. He wanted to avoid any extraordinary manifestation of Catherine's mystical experiences that would distract the huge crowds expected to attend the Masses that feast day.

But after the third Mass, when the saint had resigned herself to being denied the Blessed Sacrament, something extraordinary happened anyway. A bright light suddenly surrounded the altar. In the midst of it appeared a vision of the Holy Trinity: the Father and Son seated on thrones with the Holy Spirit above them in the form of a dove. A hand of fire holding a glowing host then emerged from the vision. The hand then placed the Eucharist upon the tongue of St. Catherine, rapt in ecstasy and surrounded by a supernatural light."

It was an extraordinarily dramatic reminder of the ordinarily non-dramatic miracle of Christ's real, passionate, loving presence in the Eucharist. In your thanksgiving after receiving Communion be sure to meditate on whom you have received, and ask for any particular grace you desire with this great gift of the Eucharist.
