Faithful Citizenship Religious Freedom Week is June 22-29

As of the writing of this announcement, the Equality Act is making its way through congress. The Equality Act works by modifying the federal Civil Rights Act of 1964 and other federal statutes concerned with discrimination and segregation. The bill defines sex to include not just biological sex characteristics, but also "sexual orientation or gender identity." The National Catholic Bioethic Center has written a joint letter to Congress out of concern of a mounting threat to conscience rights and the integrity of the medical profession. This bill would effectively mandate that all health care professionals and providers perform and pay for controversial transition-affirming therapies against their best medical judgment. The bill includes no conscience protections and explicitly removes recourse to the Religious Freedom Protection Act (RFRA). To learn more about the NCBC's concern, see the link below.

I will also have a fusion in my vertebrae. After surgery I will go to my sister's place in Dickinson ND for a few weeks. Fr. Zandri will be leading daily mass and taking one weekend. Fr. Mark McCormick will cover for one weekend, and a Ugandan priest, Fr. Godfrey Muwanga, will substitute one weekend. Fr. Godfrey served for ten years in our diocese in Spearfish and Gregory. I know I leave you in good hands. I am unclear how long recovery will take, but I intend to be back in the parish toward the end of June. Please pray that I will have a successful surgery and heal quickly. I will pray for you all and ask that the summer will bring you growth in the Holy Spirit and opportunities for recreation beyond your usual experience.

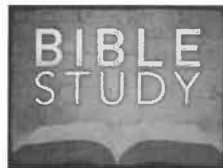
