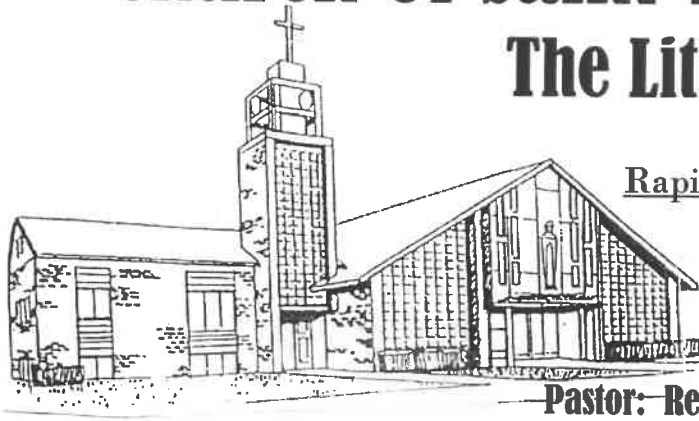

Dear Friends,

This fourth Sunday of Lent, known as Laetare Sunday, Rejoice Sunday, is meant for a moment to be a respite of Lenten penance and the rigor of fasting. While we do not fast on Sunday, Laetare is an imperative verb, a command, to rejoice. Can you rejoice on command? Can you manufacture happiness?

Like me, I am sure you would not, in all authenticity, try to live an emotion such as happiness to front your personality for anyone, let alone God who knows our hearts better than we do. But joy and happiness are not the same, nor are they necessarily emotions. We can and do experience joy for a person who has an end of suffering and the promise of eternal life while acknowledging our loss and sadness of parting.

I think Laetare Sunday is a day that embodies the reality of our sinfulness and penance while reminding us of the joy of Christ's victory over sin and death. We are three weeks now from the celebration of Easter! Today let us taste the freedom of such a victory!

Let us also remember that in our time of struggle Jesus the Lord walks with us. An old Irish proverb tells us, "God's help is nearer than the door." Let us Rejoice.

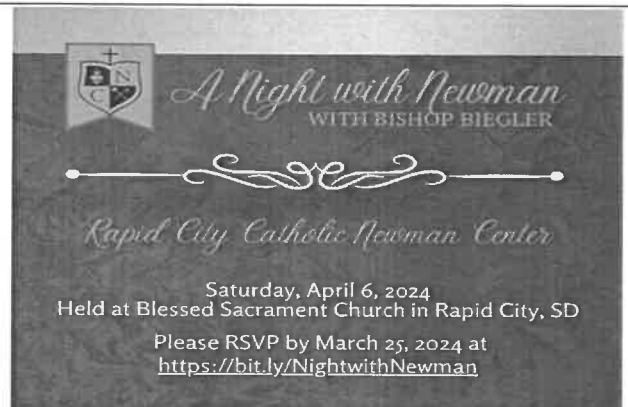
