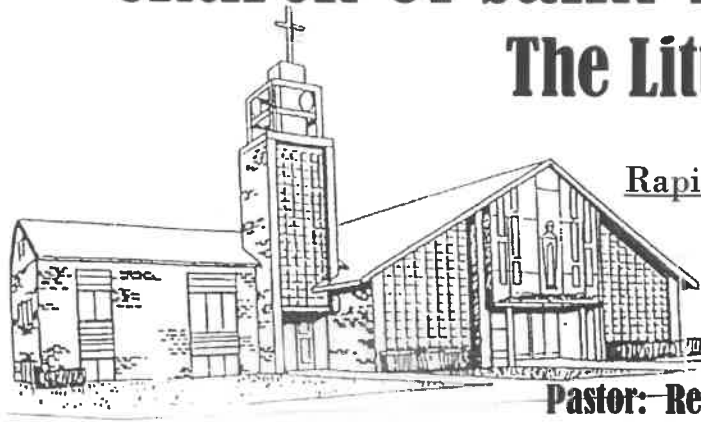

## == Fr. Kerry's Korner ==

Dear Friends,

Living in the city, we frequently have opportunities to give to the poor. Signs announce "homeless, anything helps." We are encouraged in the city to assist the locations and apostolates that assist the poor; and they are many. True discernment will help us know when we can help. Some young men I know recently went through the creek area and downtown giving out coffee. I remember thinking at the time, if I were homeless where would I get a drink of water throughout the day.

Thursday morning last, the parable of the Rich Man and Lazarus was read from the gospel of Luke 16.19-31. The story begins with the rich man stepping past the poor, starving Lazarus each day to go about his life. It ends with both dying and having between them an uncrossable chasm, Lazarus at peace with Father Abraham, the rich man tormented by flames and thirst. What caused the chasm? Is there a chasm in our life between any group, person, or virtue? In Gaudium et Spes, a Vatican II document, it says, "Remember the aphorisms of the Fathers, 'Feed the man dying of hunger, because if you have not fed him, you have killed him . . . '#69.

The Gospel, if not our own instincts, reminds us that in God's Law, the assistance we give to the poor is given in justice. Yes it is possible to be made a mark or a soft touch, but we are also being Christ for them. In his encyclical letter on the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Pope Leo XIII's encyclical on social justice Rerum Novarum from 1891, Pope John Paul II said, "Love for others, and in the first place love for the poor, in whom the Church sees Christ himself, is made concrete in the promotion of justice" (Centesimus Annus).

In our almsgiving this lent let us remember the words of 1 John 3.18, "Children, let us love not in word or speech but in deed and truth."

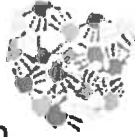

### 15<sup>th</sup> Annual RCCSS Packing Hope Event

is on the calendar for April 4th! The purpose of our Packing Hope program is to answer Christ's call to bring hope to the poor and vulnerable. Feed Just One (<https://www.thenfeedjustone.org/>) is the name of a non-profit organization located in LeMars, Iowa that distributes highly nutritious food to hungry children in the United States, Honduras, and around the world. Each student in grades PreK-8th donates \$30 to this cause, as does each member of the sophomore class. With that money, added to what we raise through our fundraising campaign, we purchase meal ingredients in bulk from Feed Just One and then work as Jesus' hands and feet to carefully funnel the ingredients into individual packages that we weigh, seal, box and ship to children in need on behalf of the Rapid City community. Since the inaugural event in 2007, the RCCSS has packed and shipped close to 1,450,000 meals, **thanks in large part to generous donations from the St. Therese parishioners.** We are hoping we can count on your help again this year. **Representatives from the STM Sophomore class will be in the gathering area following all Masses this weekend to answer your questions and collect donations.** Donations will also be accepted in care of STM Packing Hope, 300 Fairmont Blvd., Rapid City, SD 57701.
