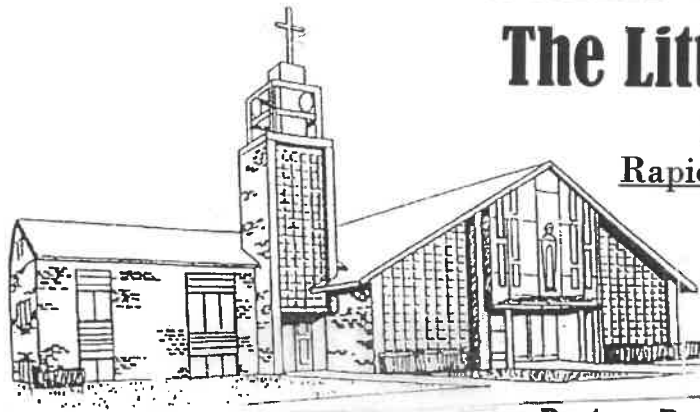

== Fr. Kerry's Korner ==

A Couple of Things: Did you know that the Vatican has the oldest, and one of the most active, diplomatic corps in the world? The Vatican, for instance, negotiated the release of the captives held in Iran, in 1980. They are now active and seeking humanitarian aid and an end of war in Ukraine. They advocate for the safety of Christians and non-Christians during times of civil unrest and aid refugees. Go to www.vatican.va and click on News to see their full page. Also www.cruXnow.com and www.catholicnewsagency.com are sites which reliably follow the Vatican news.

Lent will bring many hardships to Russia with many companies pulling out of the country. Imagine no McDonalds, Starbucks, Pepsi, or Coke. The ruble is rubble which hurts the poor more than it does the powerful. One of our national collections will be the last weekend of March. The Bishops Appeal for Overseas Relief is the almsgiving centerpiece of Lent, along with our Rice Bowls for Catholic Relief Services. Many of you have asked if there will be a special collection for Ukraine relief. Both of these collections will be a boon for the Ukrainian people and the countries taking in the millions of refugees. Thank you for your concern and keep watch for the opportunities. Our Catholic aid is always the best choice for making sure your gift gets to the people.

St. Therese, in Holy Week of 1896, when she was 23 years old, entered a darkness of soul that threatened to shake everything apart. She learned that she had tuberculosis, which at the time was incurable. But that paled in comparison to the dark night of faith which descended on her. She could not feel the presence of God. Her mind was battered by constant doubts. "Is heaven real? What comes after this life? Is it just nothingness? She was tempted to doubt Christ's promise that we will one day see him face to face. She responded by praying more and making little acts of faith hundreds of times a day, saying "Jesus, I believe in you." She did not let her emotions and feelings dictate her faith. Her last words, on September 30, 1897, were "My God, I love you!" She kept the faith. She believed, and faith had the last word.

May our continued prayers and sacrifices ensure that faith has the last word.

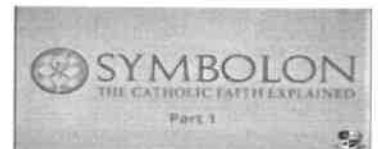
