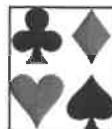

**== Fr. Kerry's Korner ==**

Dear People of God,

I have often reflected that the idea of Jesus is wonderful, and the love of Jesus is difficult. "Take up your cross every day and follow me," is the reality of loving Jesus. Choosing to honor his teaching by faithful adherence and joy is frequently challenging, because in doing so we are becoming Christ-like. And Jesus was a sign of contradiction, rejected by most, ridiculed, and put to death.

We don't desire to choose death. Dying to self is not in our self-interest. So Holy Week is a challenging and counter cultural movement of the Church in Christ. We put ourselves in the position to be rejected or ridiculed for authentic faith. Remember, like Jesus, the Father will honor the one who serves him.

Pope Francis, in a Passion Sunday message said, "His people give him a solemn welcome, yet he enters Jerusalem on a lowly colt. His people expect a powerful liberator at Passover, yet he comes to bring the Passover to fulfillment by sacrificing himself. His people are hoping to triumph over the Romans by the sword, but Jesus comes to celebrate God's triumph through the cross. What happened to those people who in a few days' time went from shouting 'Hosanna' to crying out 'Crucify him'? What happened? They were following an idea of the Messiah rather than the Messiah. They admired Jesus, but they did not let themselves be amazed by him."

Passion Sunday is March 24<sup>th</sup> and begins our Holy Week 2024. We are not to be fans. We must be disciples with a mission.
