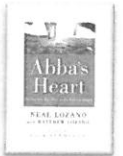

What a blessing and what a wonderful testimony to the loving power of the Holy Spirit! Our ministry name proclaims our message and mission: "Hope for New Life" for the 600 plus inmates of Pennington County Jail. Our motivation is best expressed in the words of ministry member Bill Gradoville: "I serve because it is a corporal work of mercy. We get as much out of it as the inmates do. Sharing our faith makes it stronger. Also, it has given me a new outlook on those who are incarcerated—I have more compassion." HFNL currently numbers 8 active ministry members from the parishes of Cathedral of Our Lady of Perpetual Help, Blessed Sacrament, St. Therese, and Our Lady of the Black Hills. There are also approximately 50 associated prayer partners who pray over the inmates' prayer requests collected at the end of each weekly Wednesday session.
