Dear Friends,

There is a lot of good news in the diocese. Our vocations program is bearing fruit as Fr. Mark McCormick reminds us, we are all responsible to pray for and invite young men and women to consider a vocation of service to the Church. We have four wonderful people joining our Church this Easter vigil. The Newman Center in town has eight people joining! Our confirmation class had a wonderful retreat last weekend, and we hope they can join us Holy Thursday for feet washing and the remembrance of the Lord's Supper. Our new Chancery building has been in use for several years and performs beautifully to serve the Diocese and the city. The Diocese has increased the number of people being served at the Terra Sancta retreat center and it too, attracts men and women to the spirituality of the Church.

Bishop Muhich has recently called to orders six men for the Permanent Diaconate: GW Ekroth, Gregory, St. Joseph, Jim Hulm, Timber Lake, Holy Cross, Timothy Minihan, Lead, St. Patrick, Brian Paulsen, Sturgis, St. Francis, Matthew Snyder, Hermosa, St. Michael, Phillip Thompson, Piedmont, Our Lady of the Black Hills. They will be ordained June 29th, 5:30 p.m., at the Cathedral of Our Lady of Perpetual Help. Please mark your calendars to attend!

There is a hiccup in the good news I think may be mostly involved with the hangover from the Covid 19 days. Namely, the lessened participation in everything by everyone. Some people have not come back to weekly worship. And participation in the Annual Diocesan Appeal has dropped this year by approximately 150 families throughout the Diocese. It will be difficult to reach our goal without greater participation. Cold and weather have made it difficult to get to Church and to make a pledge. The priests of the diocese and the Presbyteral Council of priests that advise Bishop Muhich have agreed to do a second ask which will be vital for the life of our church in western South Dakota. 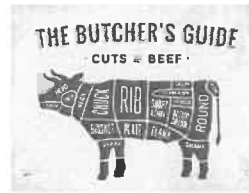
