Fr. Kerry's Korner

Dear Friends,

Bishop Peter announced this past week that he has decided to lift the dispensation given last year at the beginning of the Covid pandemic for attending Mass. I hope you received the West River Catholic and have read his letter. In arriving at this decision, he consulted most of the priests of the diocese, and insured that your personal discernment would remain an important factor in your decision to return to public celebration of the Mass.

Our document for guidance on this decision is short and very helpful. While the general dispensation is removed, there are specific instances where the dispensation will continue, as well as those circumstances where there is no obligation in the first place. One does not have an obligation to attend Mass on Sunday in the following circumstances: 1. You are ill or your health condition would be significantly compromised if you were to contract a communicable illness (i.e., you have underlying conditions or are in a high-risk category). 2. You exhibit flu-like symptoms. 3. You have good reason to think you might be asymptomatic of a contagious illness (e.g., you were in recent contact with someone who tested positive for a contagious illness such as COVID or influenza). 4. You care for the sick, homebound, or infirmed. 5. You are pregnant. 6. Those 65 years of age or older (per the CDC's recommendation of high-risk individuals). 7. You cannot attend Mass through no fault of your own (e.g., no Mass is offered, you are infirm, or, while wanting to go, you are prevented for some reason you cannot control e.g., your ride did not show up, the church was at capacity). 8. If you have significant fear or anxiety of becoming ill by being at Mass. For questions about the application of any of these, please contact your pastor. This information is also available on the Diocesan website:

www.rapidcitydiocese.org. Discernment means you pray and reflect with the help of the Holy Spirit to make an informed decision which you can act upon. Using the guidelines Bishop gave us, and remembering the importance of gathering for the Eucharist, I am sure you will do what is right.

Please remember that we will continue to livestream Sunday Mass at 9 a.m. on Facebook. We will also continue to have a Noon **Mask-required** Mass on Fridays. We rarely have more than 20 people at that Mass. Bishop Peter, or his designate will continue to have TV Mass on KNBN (NBC) on Saturdays at 4:30 pm & Sundays at 7 am or on their website: newscenter1.tv. The Mass is also available on the diocesan website: www.rapidcitydiocese.org. You should also be aware that, as the church proper is getting more full, we still have the entire social hall downstairs set up for mass on three tv's.

We are all making our way through this together. I want to thank all of you that have continued to support the parish financially and have returned as you are able to your ministry in the Church. Please don't forget our Diocese and our new Bishop Peter Muhich in your prayers and your support. He has come at a most difficult time in our history and has most faithfully exercised his ministry. He deserves our support and love.
