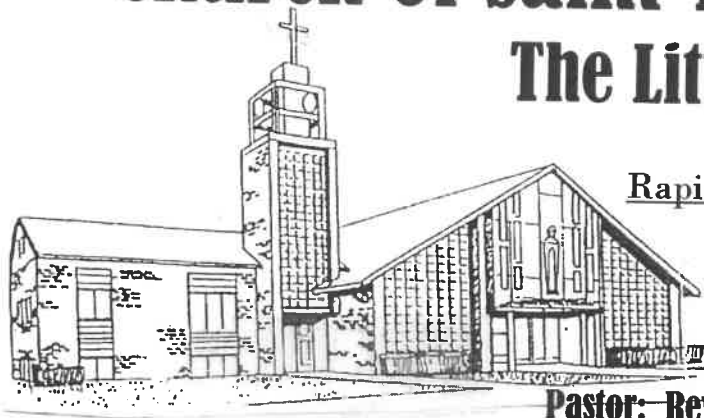

== *Fr. Michael's Memo* ==

Last weekend, someone said to me, "You need to smile more." This is something I am working on, but in my culture it is not appropriate to smile at someone you are not well acquainted with. As I spend more time in the USA, I realize many different cultural differences from food to relationships.

The next thing I have noticed is the response to my booming voice. Sometimes people interpret my loud voice as being angry or shouting at them. This is not the case. Please know that back home we don't have access to a microphone. This is also my nature when I am deep in prayerful proclamation of the message.

In the USA & Canada, I hear many people speaking of "rights" instead of "respect". I will speak about that at a later date.

Another thing I have noticed is the spiritual differences, but also commonalities, with my Church in Africa. Upon arriving in Canada, I was told that Mass should not last longer than a half, to a full hour or else "they will leave the church on me". This I learned the hard way.

😊 Back home, it is not uncommon for Mass to last hours. I have been doing my best not to have that experience here.

Here, it is refreshing to notice the dedication to the Sacraments and faithfulness of the people. I see a really awesome group of people, I love you so much. You are very much practicing Catholics. The confessional always has long lines and there is always one activity or another in the parishes. We make a lot of visits to the senior citizens homes and also individual homes. I am more busy here, but I really love the challenges.
