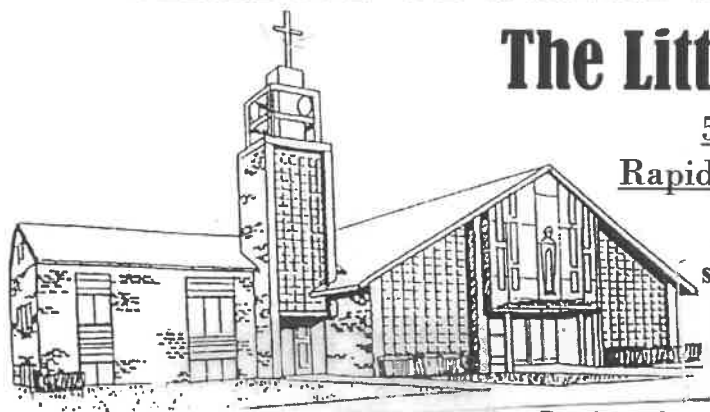

== Fr. Kerry's Korner ==

I believe I announced at only some of the masses last week that St. Therese and St. John's are getting an associate priest from Uganda. It isn't sorted yet who we will have. Fr. Francis and Fr. Leonard are arriving on the 29th of this month and will be taking some time to settle in. I can't say their last names yet, but I look forward to getting it right one day! When we have an associate, our parish will be expected to be generous in helping priests on the prairie with substitution so they can be away for vacations, retreats, or other ministry and education. They come from the same diocese, Kiyinda-Mityana, as Fr. Godfrey and Fr. Lule. We will give them a warm welcome. I hope Mother Nature will as well.

I would like to speak about some nuts and bolts, those little items you don't always think about when something is running smoothly, our church budget. When we passed our budget last June we didn't anticipate having another priest. He will be a blessing both in the cultural experience he can share with our parish of the universal Church, but also the freedom to have a priest involved in both parishes more regularly, and in ways which we have been precluded in the past. We will also incur an added financial responsibility.

Having a priest means salary, health insurance, retirement/pension contribution, retreat and education expense that goes just over forty thousand dollars. The good news is we are doing well with financial giving and running a comfortable surplus keeping up with maintenance and with the needs of the poor. The reality is that we will need to be more intentional and disciplined in our sacrificial giving in the future and persuade more parishioners to take a **meaningful and sacrificial role** in supporting the work of the Church.

This coming week the Parish Pastoral Council will be brainstorming and forecasting the needs, goals and attendant projects for the next five years. Please give them your input. It will take several meetings to discern the goals and the priority given to the goals. More to come! Thank you for all you do and as always,
