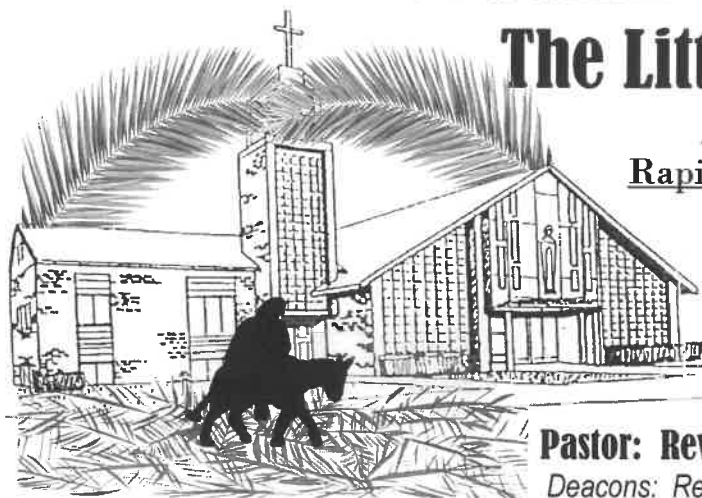

== Fr. Kerry's Korner ==

Dear Parish family,

Last year we had a family blessing and a drive by distribution of palms to begin the loneliest Holy Week of my life. It is a blessing to be able to gather this year and to experience the desire for the Eucharist that comes from having been without. It has been a long and hard time for our church. I am so pleased with the way so many of you have kept in touch and cared for your neighbors during these difficult times.

We have been adjusting to the increase of visitors and parishioners at Mass already. Our experience has been that we have sufficient room so far by including the Social Hall for additional seating. The downstairs seating is not optimal, but it is the best and safest option for those who really need to social distance.

Going forward, Bishop Peter has asked all parishes to have a **Saturday night Mass with masks required and social distancing**. All the parishes in the Rapid City area are implementing this request. We will begin the **first weekend after Easter**.

Saturday and Sunday evening you can be assured that the Church has sanitized the surfaces of the pews. We will discontinue the sanitizing after every Mass and replace that discipline with availability of hand sanitizer in the Church which you can access at the entrances, in the Parish Hall, and in the communion line. Our best protection is to not touch our eyes, mouth, or nose with our hands unless we have washed our hands.

Our Sunday Masses will be more open. Upstairs we will not have pews marked off. You will be free to seat yourself using your own judgement. Sunday evening remains our least attended Mass and is, therefore, the easiest time to be distanced. We have seating downstairs for 96 people with excellent social distancing. **Remember we will continue to have a Mass on Friday at noon with mask required.**

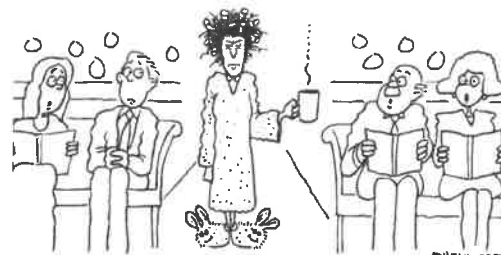
