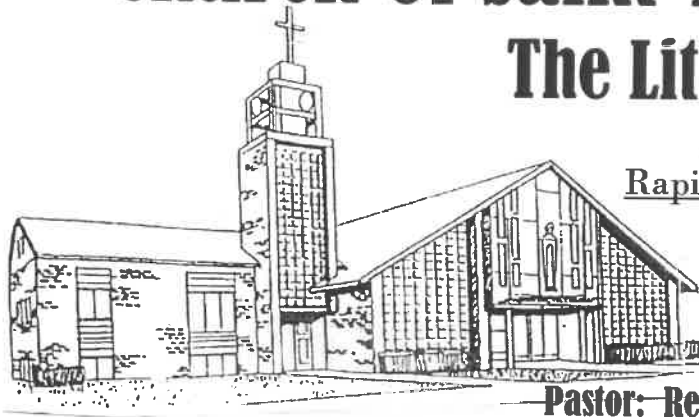

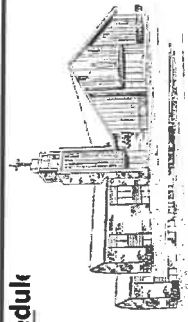

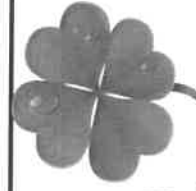

== Fr. Kerry's Korner ==

Memorial Tribute for Bishop Peter Muhich by Fr. Kerry Prendiville

We received Bishop Peter as our new shepherd just over three and half years ago. It was the time of covid, of social distancing, of learning how to be present to as many as possible in the digital age. He would comment in solidarity with all introverts, "I was made for this." But it would take a bit more time to get to know our new bishop and see the man of faith that his brother priests in Duluth knew.

We received a pastor taught by his parishioners in his home parish of Eveleth in the Iron Range, educated in the Twin Cities and Belgium, responsible for many different ministries and entrusted with many service positions of trust. I am sure his coming to the Diocese of Rapid City was a great loss to the Duluth presbyterate, but it was felt most sacrificially by his dear parents, Louis and Sally. They, more than any, have experienced what it means when a son puts his hand to the plow and does not look back. He was sent here in life by our Holy Father, and he would remain here in death, as he explained to his brother Paul a few days before he died, "It is like I am married to this Diocese, I belong here now." Mr. and Mrs. Muhich, as you are with us with livestream, please accept our condolences and profound gratitude for the gift of your son.

He involved every priest in parishes in the diocese along with representatives from every parish into the Strategic planning process, Flourishing Families. It was a process he helped develop when he was a pastor, tweaked by a committee of our priests. In this process, with parish listening sessions and town halls, many of our people began to believe that they were well and truly consulted to develop a new model of clustering our parishes to best utilize our priest resources and sharing our gifts and talents. The week before he died, he met with the head of that committee to assure that implementation would continue.

From the beginning of his diagnosis with esophageal cancer, to the news at various stages of his treatment, to the discomforts of swallowing, to the impossibility of swallowing and the use of his feeding tube, Bishop Peter was prayerful, courageous, and serene. He placed his trust in Our Lady of Perpetual Help and Our Lady of the Rosary. With that deep faith and serenity he could be both Bishop and Father to his priests, encouraging the downhearted, anointing the sick, and warming us all with genuine and authentic concern.

It was during this time that I was reminded of Jesus gazing toward Jerusalem in Luke chapter 9: When the days for his being taken up* were fulfilled, he resolutely determined to journey to Jerusalem. In the words of the prophet Isaiah, he turned his face like flint. There was determination to continue to govern with the able assistance of his remarkable staff, teach by his witness of patient endurance what it means to die to self and rise with Christ. And finally, to sanctify, to encourage us to greater union with the Lord, by his offering of his sufferings for the renewal of us all through faith in our Eucharistic Lord, Bishop Peter's Viaticum, our food for the Journey, his body, blood, soul, and divinity.

I wish to thank also Archbishop Hebda for your wise counsel and support for Bishop Peter and our Diocese, Bishop Donald DeGrood for being his good friend and neighbor and for your generous assistance going forward, and for Bishops Gruss and Biegler and all his brother bishops and priests who have come to pray and honor him in these farewells. And finally to his Chancery staff, Sr. Christine et al, his Cathedral staff, Fr. Brian Christiansen and team for all the arrangements and hospitality.

Lord of All, receive the sacrifice of your servant and our shepherd Peter and give him rest from his labors. Let his good deeds accompany him.

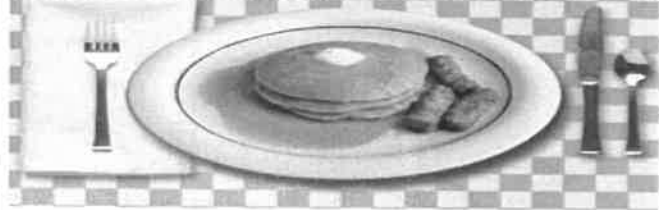
