

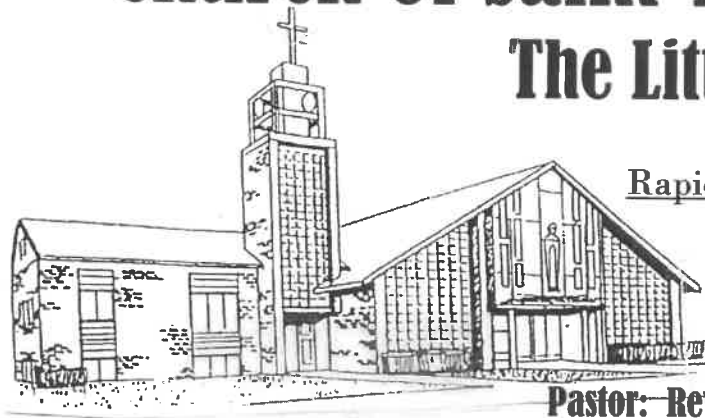

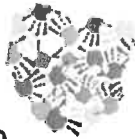

Live Different: Catholic Men's Conference

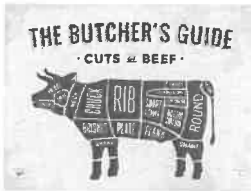
March 11, Saturday, 8am-4pm | Terra Sancta Retreat Center

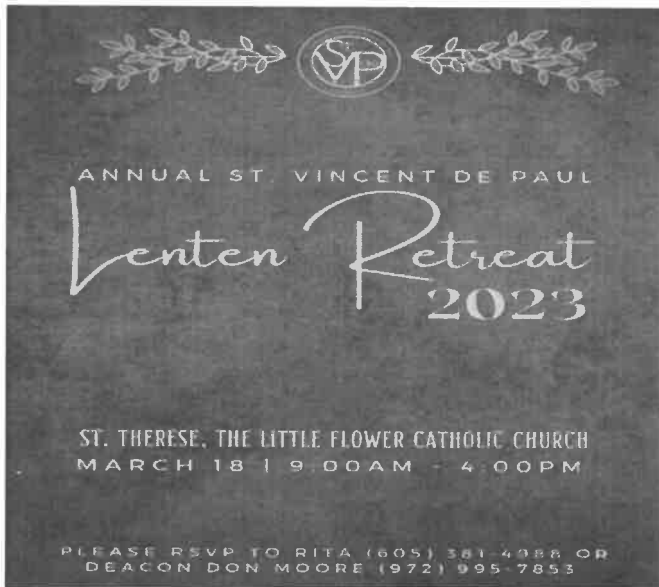

15th Annual RCCSS Packing Hope Event

is on the calendar for April 4th! The purpose of our Packing Hope program is to answer Christ's call to bring hope to the poor and vulnerable. Feed Just One (<https://www.thenfeedjustone.org/>) is the name of a non-profit organization located in LeMars, Iowa that distributes highly nutritious food to hungry children in the United States, Honduras, and around the world. Each student in grades PreK-8th donates \$30 to this cause, as does each member of the sophomore class. With that money, added to what we raise through our fundraising campaign, we purchase meal ingredients in bulk from Feed Just One and then work as Jesus' hands and feet to carefully funnel the ingredients into individual packages that we weigh, seal, box and ship to children in need on behalf of the Rapid City community. Since the inaugural event in 2007, the RCCSS has packed and shipped close to 1,450,000 meals, thanks in large part to generous donations from the St. Therese parishioners. We are hoping we can count on your help again this year. Representatives from the STM Sophomore class will be speaking and collecting donations the weekend of March 11-12. Donations will also be accepted in care of STM Packing Hope, 300 Fairmont Blvd., Rapid City, SD 57701. Thank you for prayerful consideration of this cause.
