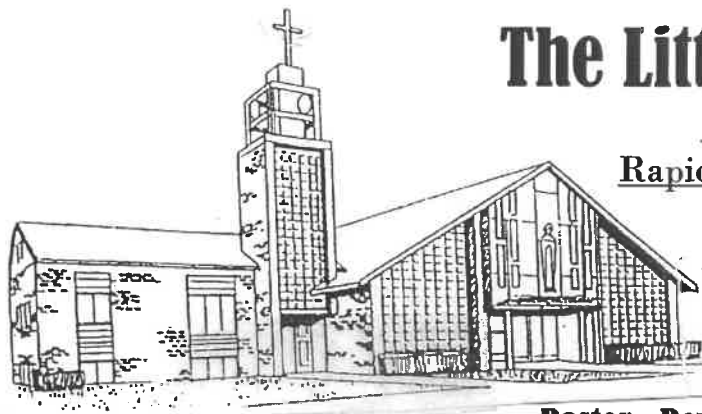

### == Fr. Kerry's Korner ==

Dear Friends,

The devastating war in Ukraine and the rapacious aggression of Vladimir Putin have rocked Europe and all leaders of nations and have united some to oppose the nation of Russia. Putin's war is bringing unparalleled suffering to ordinary people and is racking up war crimes as they target non-combatants.

For those of us who believe it is time to oppose both the evil in our thoughts and actions, and to stand in solidarity with the nation of Ukraine and the Catholic Church, this past Ash Wednesday the Holy Father asked the whole world to pray and fast for Ukraine and the end of war. On this first Sunday of Lent, as we already have taken upon ourselves a "campaign of Christian service", let us continue to offer real sacrifice of prayer fasting and almsgiving.

It has worked before! Our Lady of Fatima promised the world that the rosary would bring about the conversion of Russia. The fall of the Soviet Union and the freedoms that its satellite countries experienced the burgeoning of religious freedom came about through her intercession. Because it has worked before, let us again offer our rosaries to the Queen of Peace for the conversion of Putin and for the religious freedom of our brothers and sisters in Russia and Ukraine and in every land where there is political and religious strife that threatens the peace of God's people.

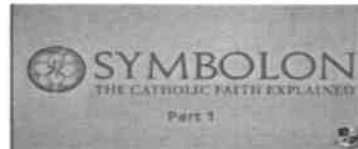

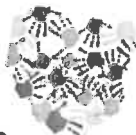
