An Update from the Hope For New Life (HFNL) Jail Ministry Reaching Out to Prisoners

Our inspiration comes from many sources. In the daily devotional magazine, *Living Faith*, Sr. Joyce Rupp, writing the entry for February 6th, urges with Saint Paul: "Respect for the Prisoner". She reminds us that "Paul had been jailed more than once" and goes on to say, "No wonder he urged others to be 'mindful of prisoners' as if they themselves were one of them [Hebrews 13:3]. There are many good people in prison who have hurt others by their poor choices and hard-hearted decisions. It is easy to judge them as 'worthless'...but we do not know what their early lives lacked in comparison to ours or what happened in their mind and heart to lead them astray." Sister Rupp cautions, "This perspective does not condone crimes or deny the need for justice. However, no matter what wrongdoing someone did, each continues to be a human being filled with the same divine presence that inhabits us. Prisoners deserve to be treated with the basic respect that we desire for ourselves." It is in this spirit that the HFNL Ministry reaches out to the inmates of Pennington County Jail.
