

Sign of Peace - In the Our Father we have prayed to forgive as we are forgiven. That prayer is acted upon in the Sign of Peace. The first greeting of Jesus to his apostles after the resurrection in John's gospel was "Peace be with you." We are invited to offer each other the peace that Jesus, who is present with us, desires to give. Recall that signs and gestures communicate something to God and others. The Sign of Peace is not a secular greeting, not a "Hi, how are you?" It is a time to extend to one another a sign of Christ's peace, not our own. Christ's "Peace" in Hebrew is Shalom. It denotes wholeness or completeness. and perfection. This "Peace" is really a blessing, a manifestation of divine grace. Done properly, the Sign of Peace does not distract us from receiving the Lord in communion. Rather it invites us into this union with Jesus. Jesus present with us offers peace to his followers through the ritual of the community in word and action. We are invited to offer Christ's peace in this ritual moment, to those around us whom we do not know, and even to our enemies.

The position provides continuity and coordination with other members of the staff, participation in staff planning and operational meetings and significant dialogue with the pastor so that he is fully apprised of matters being considered. Must be sensitive to the nature of information he/she has access to and must treat it confidentially. 




