Dear Friends,

I write to you to share the joyful news that we will begin public
Masses again on Saturday, May 16. All are welcome, but you
must call to have a seating reservation. To keep social distance,
we have a seating chart that requires you to call ahead. Please
contact the office at 605-342-1556 between 8 am and 4 pm,
Monday thru Friday, or dial "0" and leave a message.

While we are now permitted to attend Masses, the obligation to
do so is still suspended. Therefore, to accommodate everyone,
we ask that you sign up for one weekday or weekend Mass so
you can receive Our Lord in the Eucharist. You must use your
judgement about coming to public Mass. We will continue to
live-stream the Mass each Sunday on the St. Therese Facebook
page.

The Sunday Masses on May 17 are reserved for our 20 first
Solemn Communion children and their families.

Please be patient with us during this unprecedented time. We
are adapting the rules set by the US Catholic Conference of
Bishops (USCCB) and the guidelines of the CDC and the state
of South Dakota.

The daily Mass schedule will be Monday, Wednesday, and
Friday at 7:30 am and Tuesday and Thursday at Noon.
Weekend Masses will stay the same.

How can you help? We are seeking volunteers for

Concluding Rite – Mass does not end with the reception of Holy Eucharist. We have become a living tabernacle of the most precious Body and Blood of Jesus and should reflect on that and all gifts God has given you. A new Rite begins which brings the whole of the celebration to a conclusion and prepares us for the life that comes next. After any announcements comes the blessing. This can be simple or a more solemn three-fold blessing on special occasions. While the wording for the final blessing is not changing, it should be noted that the priest does not bestow the blessing by saying, "In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit." Rather, by virtue of his ordination and his standing in the person of Christ, the priest simply invokes the Holy Trinity, and it is God the Father who grants the blessing through His ordained minister.
