

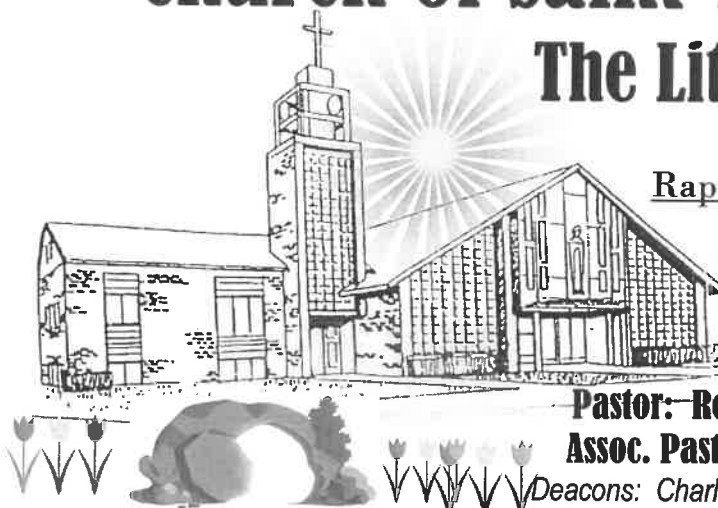

City-wide Eucharistic Procession: June 11, Sunday, on the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, a Eucharistic Procession will commence from the Cathedral OLPH, 520 Cathedral Dr., Rapid City, along 5th St., to the Memorial Park Bandshell. Schedule: Mass 3 p.m., procession 4:30 p.m., followed by a picnic sponsored by local Knights of Columbus. Those who recently received 1st Communion are invited to wear their 1st Communion attire. Join the procession anywhere along the way. For questions call the cathedral — 605-342-0507.

Dear Friends,

"Scandal, division, disease, doubt. The Church has withstood each of these throughout our very human history. But today we confront all of them, all at once. Our response at this moment is pivotal. Amid these roaring waves, Jesus is present, reminding us that he is more powerful than the storm. He desires to heal, renew, and unify the Church and the world. How will he do it? By uniting us once again around the source and summit of our faith in the celebration of the Eucharist. The National Eucharistic Revival is the joyful, expectant, grassroots response of the entire Catholic Church in the U.S. to this divine invitation."

We are invited to participate in a city-wide procession. I would like to have many folks from St. Therese represented with our banner, our First Communicants and families, and organizations. Procession with the Eucharist is an ancient tradition dating back farther than St. Ambrose of Milan who died at the end of the fifth century. The procession reminds us of the leaving of Mass where we are sent to bring Christ to others in words and actions, "Go to love and serve the Lord."

They became especially popular during the counter Reformation when Catholic belief in the real presence was challenged to witness in the streets and affirm for us that God wanted a eucharistic people to remember Jesus was always with them. The Council of Trent taught, in 1551, that the Most Blessed Sacrament "is to be honored with extraordinary festive celebrations (and) solemnly carried from place to place in processions according to the praiseworthy universal rite and custom of the holy Church."

Recently in prayer, I was reminded of the beautiful processions with the rosary at Lourdes and Fatima. It was put on my heart (that means it isn't going away!) to offer a process for the elderly, the halt and lame, with Our Lady of Lourdes from our parish shrine to meet the procession from the Cathedral. While I can certainly make the walk from Cathedral myself, that is why I have paid big money for four joint replacements, I feel called to offer this shorter route for those who would like to go. A shorter route for the Eucharistic procession is also available by starting from Immaculate Conception Church. Rides are arranged to go back to either ICC or the Cathedral after the event.

This will be an event of faith, witness and praise!

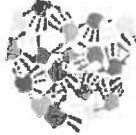
