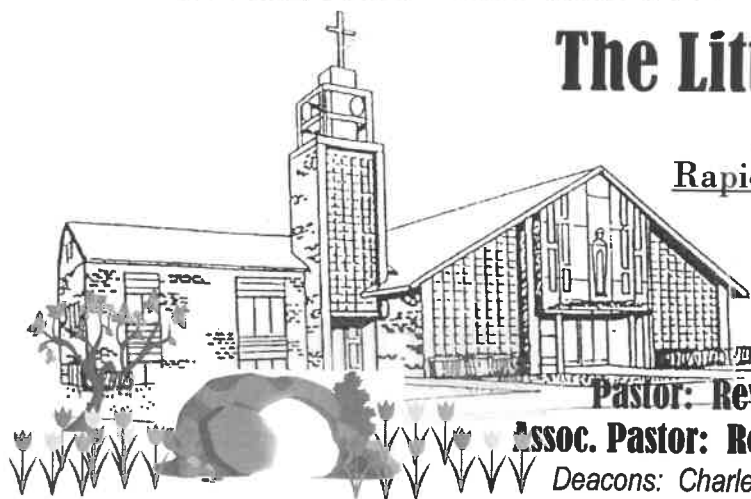

## == Fr. Kerry's Korner ==

One of the tasks the Finance and Pastoral Councils do every May is the work of developing a Church budget. Budgets keep us on track to our goals, they reflect our values as a Church community, and they aid in wise stewardship of the gifts you sacrifice to help St. Therese. As part of that process, every so often we brainstorm ideas that will keep our community growing and responding to the needs of the Church. We also forecast responsible maintenance needs and anticipate major repairs.

Our three-to-five-year goals involve more discernment and exploration, parish input, and learning. We are considering a sanctuary renovation project that would be a result of the study of church architecture and design, and the documents of the church related to liturgical function and aesthetics. Much of the sanctuary space is currently taken up by a music and liturgy sacristy on the right, and the Blessed Sacrament Chapel on the left. A redesign of the sanctuary could accommodate the return of the Tabernacle to the altar area, moving the position of the president's chair, increase room for music and choir, upgrade our sound system and its performance with better placement of outlets, design the lighting so everyone is able to see and bring it up to the LED standard of the rest of our facility. Other projects might be better done integrated into this effort especially the fire alarm and suppression system, and installing a video projection capability in the Church.

In this longer period of time we will begin studying church architecture and liturgical documents that are the result of mature reflection of the Church after Vatican Council II almost sixty years ago. To this end, our Parish Pastoral Council and the Finance Council will be attending a public presentation by Dr. Denis McNamara formerly of Mundelein Seminary, near Chicago, where he served as Academic Director and Associate Professor at the Liturgical Institute. You are all invited to this presentation May 24, 7 pm at the Holy Cross Chapel, Terra Sancta retreat center. We will be scheduling adult formation along the lines of spirituality, prayer and liturgical worship in the summer and coming year.
