## **== Fr. Kerry's Korner ==**

*Let love be sincere; hate what is evil, hold on to what is good;  
love one another with mutual affection;  
anticipate one another in showing honor.*

*Do not grow slack in zeal, be fervent in spirit, serve the Lord.  
Rejoice in hope, endure in affliction, persevere in prayer.*

*Romans 12:9-12*

Brothers and sisters, the priest I was ordained with the evening of June 7, 1984, Fr. Dennis Riss, chose this passage for our ordination Mass from Paul's letter to the Romans 12.1-12. This closing admonition and encouragement has been the challenge of my priesthood; no more so than in the past few months with the closure of public Mass.

As we begin the careful process of coming back to worship, at the beginning of the tourist season, with people of all ages and states of health, we will face confusion and anxiety as we get used to the idea and the reality of "All are welcome. Call for a seat reservation." It is not the motto or the mission statement we would have chosen for our parish!

The bon mote, "it is what it is" comes to mind. I discovered, out of curiosity, that it probably was coined in 1949 by J. E. Lawrence in the Nebraska State Journal writing about the land, "New land is harsh, and vigorous, and sturdy. It scorns evidence of weakness. There is nothing of sham or hypocrisy in it. It is what it is, without an apology." Since then the phrase has been increasingly popular. While it can denote resignation or apathy, the phrase originally related more to reality, determination, and strength.

For all who have found it difficult to make reservations, or even considered us foolish for all the precautions, I thank you for your patience, endurance, hopefulness, perseverance, and prayerfulness. I especially want to thank my wonderful staff for their planning, due diligence, and cheerfulness as they accompany the parish down this new road. They are going above and beyond, and I hope you return their hard work with your patience and understanding. It is what it is; it is still changing.

We have different ways of looking at the Covid -19 pandemic because we are getting the news about it from many different sources. Remember the precautions aren't only for you and your family, but for all. When you feel you are on your last nerve with this whole business, I ask you to close your eyes and remember Paul's word, "Anticipate one another in showing honor."

**Dismissal** - Following our response of "Amen" to the final blessing, Mass is concluded with the dismissal, said by the priest or a deacon, using one of the following dismissal formulas: - Go forth, the Mass is ended. - Go and announce the Gospel of the Lord. - Go in peace, glorifying the Lord by your life. - Go in peace.

The dismissal is a mandate by the Lord. While the Mass may be concluded, our real purpose now begins. We are to go and live as Catholic disciples of Jesus through our words and actions at home, at work or school, and with family and friends.

Our response at the dismissal remains the same: "Thanks be to God." What else can we do except give thanks to God? Our prayer of thanksgiving to the Lord is coming to an end. We have received the greatest gift possible in our hearts. We have encountered and received Jesus. We are filled with gratitude and thanksgiving. However, the encounter with the Lord is not finished. We really attend Mass in order to be in the presence of our God through His Son Jesus, who then sends us forth to be Christ in the world. This sending out, this commissioning by God, is the crucial conclusion of the Mass. It is the intentional desire of the Lord for his disciples to go out and be his Christ's light in this world, his living presence.
