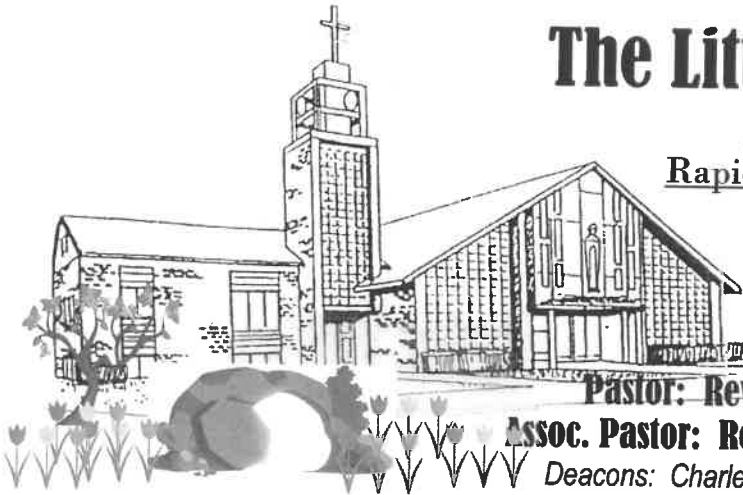

## == Fr. Kerry's Korner ==

Dear Friends,

One of the tasks the Finance and Pastoral Councils do every May is the work of developing a Church budget. Budgets keep us on track to our goals, they reflect our values as a Church community, and they aid in wise stewardship of the gifts you sacrifice to help St. Therese. As part of that process, every so often we brainstorm ideas that will keep our community growing and responding to the needs of the Church. We also forecast responsible maintenance needs and anticipate major repairs.

The goals that came to the top for pastoral work are reaching out to Box Elder community for the next three years and partnering with the other Catholic parishes in Rapid City giving a major push to the St. Vincent DePaul ministry. In addition, participating in the three-year Eucharistic Revival in the United States in every facet of formation.

For the good of our facilities, ambitious one-year goals are:

- 1--Upgrade the Fire Alarm system to city code.
- 2--Follow the results of the HVAC study we are doing to address the aging system for greater efficiencies and performance.
- 3--Install new sprinkler system for the lawns.
- 4--Purchase a new dishwasher for the kitchen.
- 5--Check the insulation in the rectory and augment if necessary.
- 6--Make the lower-level mobile phone friendly.
- 7--Enhance our Web presence and communication possibilities.

Next week, I will try to share the 3-5 year-goals.

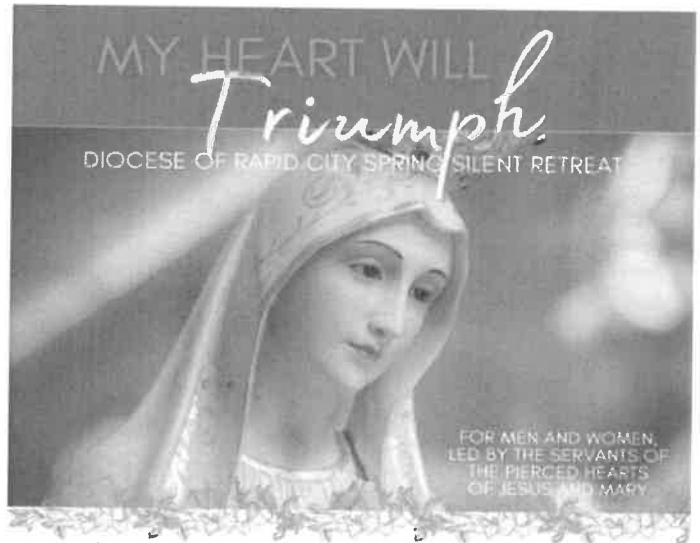

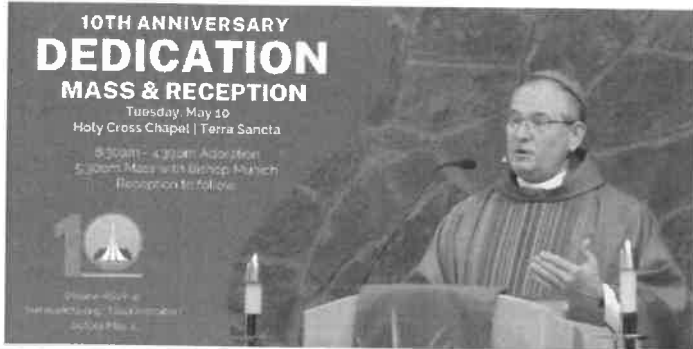
