== Fr. Kerry's Korner ==

Dear Friends,

It is better for you that I go. For if I do not go, the Advocate (Holy Spirit) will not come to you (Jn 16:7).

The day of Ascension found the disciples in the gathering place in Jerusalem where they had the Last Supper with Jesus. They were sad in the presence of the Lord because they could not imagine life without the body of the Lord in their midst. St. Peter Julian Eymard observed when Jesus then led them to the Mount of Olives out of sight of Jerusalem, it was the first Christian procession. There he would command them to carry on: witness and baptize.

Even though he had promised that when he would go he would send the Advocate, who would always be with them, they were completely subject to what they had seen and not what they would do. Finally, angels appeared to them and said, "Men of Jerusalem, why do you stand looking at the sky?" There is a time for reflection and a time for action!

St. Augustine preaching on the Solemnity of the Ascension said, "Today our Lord Jesus Christ ascended into heaven; let our hearts ascend with him. Listen to the words of the Apostle: If you have risen with Christ, set your hearts on the things that are above where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God; seek the things that are above, not the things that are on earth. For just as he remained with us even after his ascension, so we too are already in heaven with him, even though what is promised us has not yet been fulfilled in our bodies."

Christ who came down to earth was fully present in heaven! Christ who went to heaven by the glorification of the Father, remains forever with us on earth! We are united with Jesus on earth, and by grace, we are one with him in heaven.

We now await the glorious promise of Jesus, the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, our Pentecost!

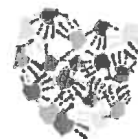

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,
