

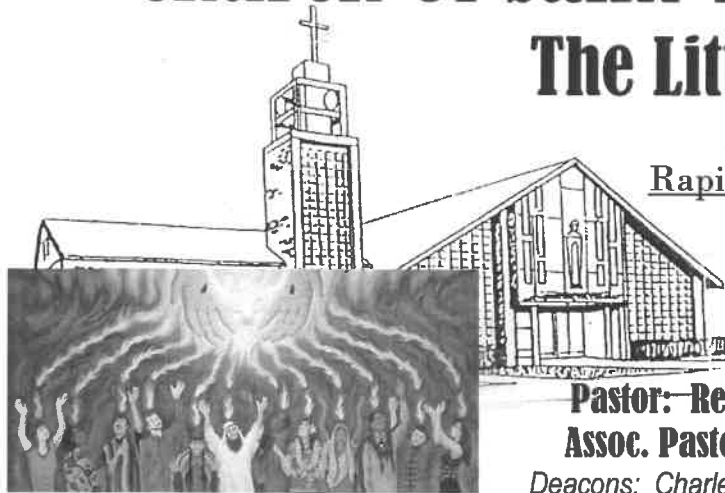

== Fr. Kerry's Korner ==

Blessed Pentecost Everyone!

Fifty days after Easter we conclude the Easter season with this solemnity of power. It wasn't the power of fireworks or feats of strength. It was the power that makes weakness defeat strength. The outpouring of the Holy Spirit is the gift of love between the Father and the Son. The Holy Spirit proceeds from the Father and the Son as a gift of love. It is the fulfillment of the promise Jesus made to send us an Advocate to be with us always, that he would remain with us always, and that he would come back for us so that where he is we may be. And we are with him always in the indwelling spirit.

I had a very unusual experience this week that played out while I was at Clergy Days. A good woman from the parish informed me that Facebook Messenger sent out (without my knowledge or permission) a nasty picture. It was in fact a pornographic picture and I have no idea who or how many people received it. So far only one person I know. I have seen things come in from others without their knowledge or consent, but to my knowledge this is the first time it has happened to me. I always thought if you didn't click on the link, you would be fine. There is no way to ensure that it will not happen again.

I love Facebook and Messenger. We have a family chat group where we can inform, interact, argue, joke, pick on, and reminisce. I have enjoyed catching up with high school classmates scattered after we graduated from boarding school. I didn't want to lose that. But I also wanted to have peace of mind. I decided to unplug.

The first day I kept looking at my phone every few minutes. I picked up books that were laying beside my chair in the evening and read more. I went to bed more relaxed. Did I say I kept looking at my phone every few minutes? I discovered that if you are really in withdrawal, you can find amazing cat videos on other platforms!

I had not realized how much time I was giving to the Facebook community. I was going far beyond what I intended and wasting too much time. Day three I am looking at my phone less. I am finding more freedom to think about important matters. I seem less distracted in prayer and my phone is starting to serve me again. It really is a new beginning. Pentecost is about new beginnings. What will we be surprised with in these days?

Look to the power of God in your weakness. Imagine what is possible. Pray that the Lord will use you and your gifts.

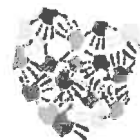

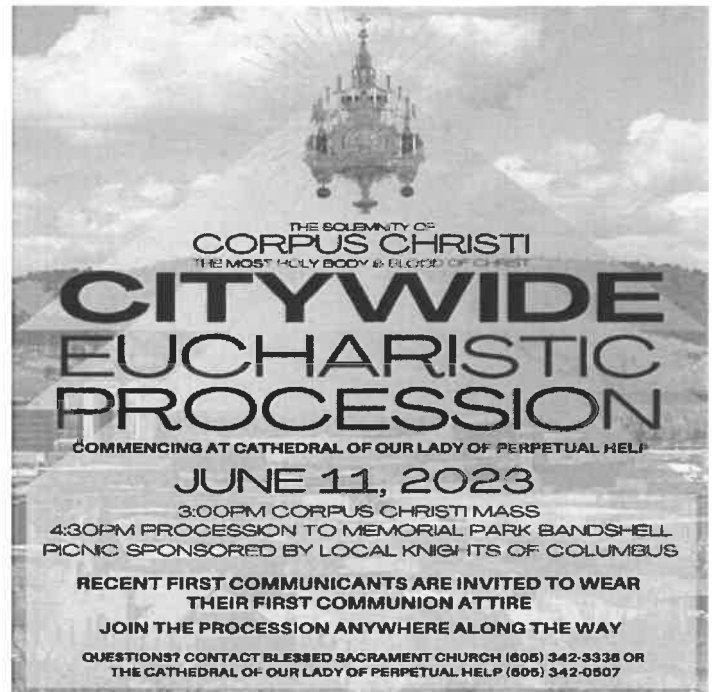
