== *Fr. Francis's File* ==

THE BLOOD OF MARTYRS IS A SEED OF CHRISTIANITY IN UGANDA In 1875, King Muteesa I of Buganda requested an American visitor to Uganda, Henry M. Stanley, to write a letter inviting the missionaries to Uganda. The first missionaries to come were the Anglican in 1877 from England. The Catholic Missionaries from France arrived in Uganda in 1879. They were Fr. Simon Lourdel and Br. Amans Delmas. Christianity spread faster because the missionaries were so friendly, their language seemed to be simple and no circumcision like their friends the Moslems who came earlier in 1844.

BUT WHY A PERSECUTION TOOK PLACE? One day the King's palace caught on fire and many traditional properties were destroyed. The Elders blamed a young King Mwanga who had just become a king in 1884, for having accepted the Missionaries to come and they are the sole cause of the tragedy. They continued telling him that the gods are not happy and that is why the misfortune has happened. Fortunately, or unfortunately, many of his pages were becoming Catholics and were baptized by the Missionaries and these boys were on fire with the Catholic faith, no more to Traditional religion. They loved and appreciated the faith because it was sweet for them like honey. The converts were very organized and they had formed the Christian communities in Kampala, the capital city of Uganda, and in Kiyinda Mityana Diocese where I come from. Charles Lwanga was the leader of the young pages, sustaining their faith by word and example and led them on the way to martyrdom. Charles Lwanga met his death where the Basilica stands. They could gather and have Mass, plus other sacraments every week. Those from Mityana had to walk 50 miles in two days to go back and preach to their friends back home what the Missionaries had preached to them! You can really wonder about the Divine intervention! These people were not studied, yet understood the language of the Missionaries, and the roads were not there back then for them to travel easily!! Christianity spread like wildfire and the King also joined but he abandoned it quickly. Maybe he could not stand the criticisms of the Elders. He warned his pages to give up the Christian faith, but the boys would not listen and they continued going, even escaping the palace at night to go for catechism instructions.

The day of darkness in the eyes of a common man yet the day of Light for Martyrs took place!! One afternoon the king came back from hunting. It was a bad day for him as he didn't catch anything and his spear was taken by the hippopotamus as he was trying to shoot it. This made him so angry he went back home with annoyance. Reaching home, the boys were not there to welcome him back as usual. He asked a bystander where the boys had gone. The bystander told him he had seen them going for Catechism. I bet you can imagine what the king looked like by that time! He was about to burst of anger! He moved up and down not fitting in his chair, pacing in his courtyard. Then the boys came running back thinking the king was still hunting. The king pulled out his spear and shot the boy who appeared first before him. The king ordered the council meeting at night and all the boys were brought forward. They were cautioned and intimidated with death, but the boys showed they are ready to

die for Jesus and not to miss eternal life. The king ordered Mukajanga, the chief executioner, to burn to death the boys at Namugongo. They were burnt on 3rd June 1886. They were 22 boys from 13 to 50 years old. They were killed, but Christianity continued to spread like wildfire. This is why I say, the blood of Martyrs is the seed of Christianity. They were canonized saints by Pope Paul VI in 1964. For that matter therefore Uganda became a land of martyrs where people all over the World, United States included, travel to on 3rd June for pilgrimage. How I wish parishioners of St. Therese could join me and make a pilgrimage to Uganda!

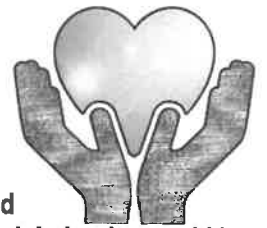
