### Fr. Kerry's Korner

Dear friends,

In the early middle ages, there was a great saint of Ireland Brigid of Kildare. St. Brigid was second only to St. Patrick in helping develop the great faith of the Irish people. She founded an influential monastery at Kildare which was a bright light of learning and prayer. One of her religious sisters was blind. One evening they spent talking about God, the Trinity, and mysteries of faith well into the night. In fact, the sun was beginning to rise when Brigid looked to her companion with pity and prayed that she would be able to see the beauty of the sunrise. When Sr. Dara realized that she could see a golden ball of light and noticed the sun glinting off dew on the flowers, she turned to Brigid and said, "close my eyes again dear Mother, for when the world is so visible to my eyes, it is much more difficult to see the mysteries of God."

Not one of us would choose to be blind, but imagine, if our eyes do not allow us to praise the God of creation, have they really served our body?

Trinity Sunday remembers the central mystery of our faith, three persons in one God, that is always destined to be a truth seen dimly, casting the light of a thousand suns. We may fully comprehend it when we see God face to face. Or we may continue to gaze on so deep a mystery that only be described as love.

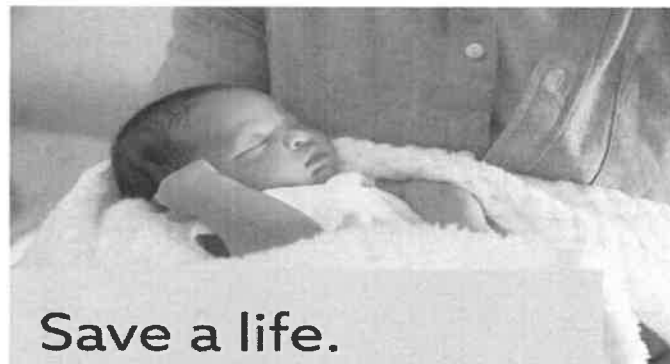
