== Fr. Kerry's Korner ==

Dear Friends,

We have now had full 2 weeks of Mass celebrated in the parishes. From this experience, we continue tuning the process, and have a few changes to announce:

1. **Weekday masses are open with no seating reservations necessary.** We will still social distance in open pews, but there hasn't been enough people to make a weekday Mass seating chart. We will start again if needed.
2. We are seeking **check-in hosts & hostesses** to show those attending Mass their seat assignment and sit in the Parish Center throughout Mass in case someone needs assistance. You will participate from there and receive the Eucharist with the others.
3. We also need **hospitality ushers** to aid the host and hostess prior to Mass (if needed). For Mass, you will sit in the south exit foyer, and hand out bulletins and assist during Mass if needed.
4. For now, we need a new schedule for a fewer number of **ministers of the altar**. We are in need of **Altar Servers** (willing to serve alone or with someone else from your household). **Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist** need to mask while giving Our Lord. *There will be some special training, for instance, what to do if you accidentally make contact while giving communion on the tongue.* If you would like to continue your ministry, please call the office for more details.
5. If you are able to be a **section cleaner**, please mention that when making your seating reservation for Mass. **We need 6 per Mass.**
6. **We will add a Saturday 4 pm Mass** starting June 6. *There may be acapella music at this Mass.* Beginning June 6 we will move **Confession time to Saturdays from 2:45-3:45 p.m. and Saturday and Sunday evening after the 5:30 Mass until all are heard.**

We continue to ask you to be kind, be safe, and be joyful in the Lord.
