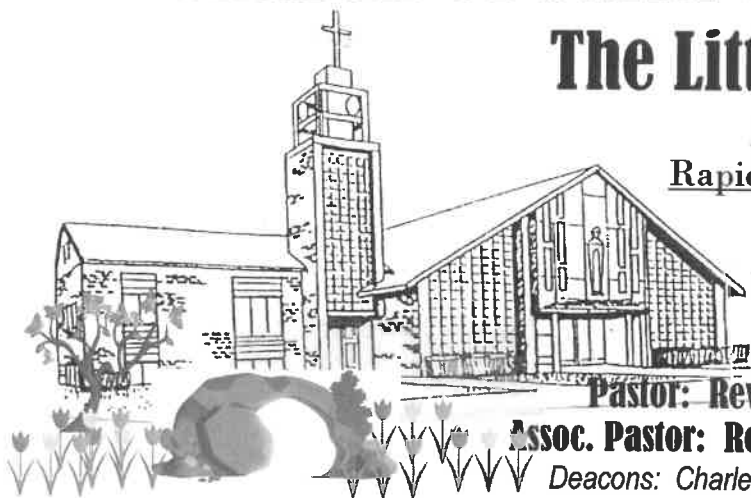

== Fr. Kerry's Korner ==

"My sheep hear my voice; I know them, and they follow me. I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish. No one can take them out of my hand." John 10.27-28

These words from John's gospel are powerful and brief. I was thinking of them this past week as an elderly man lay dying. His son was holding his hand; his daughter-in-law was giving him a cool cloth. I was praying the words of the Church's rite, "Go forth faithful Christian. . ." In this context the words are soothing and so appropriate. We are consoled to hear them. But death doesn't always come at a time when we can say with serenity "there is a time to live and a time to die." Death can come suddenly, unexpectedly, a result of violence or neglect, of persecution or national aggression.

Today as Putin's Russia has invaded Ukraine and sets its sights on Moldova, operating from land belonging to Ukraine, the Crimean Peninsula, targeted civilians, and soldiers are dying with a refrain of injustice on their lips, calling out to God who knows the voice of the suffering. I remain in these words, "No one can take them out of my hand." While Putin is channeling his inner Stalin, the Good Shepherd claims his own.

Everywhere there exists the hatred that will kill the ones who seek the freedom of the children of God to worship. St. John in Revelation says of them, "These are the ones who have survived the time of great distress; they have washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb." The very blood of their life claimed by evil, becomes the means of their glory. They are in Christ, die with Christ, and enter their glory with the Lamb.

Can our prayers, sacrifices, and solidarity help the persecuted keep faith and strength? Let us first be renewed in mind and heart and know that no one can separate us from the love of God.

The one who sits on the throne will shelter them. They will not hunger or thirst anymore, nor will the sun or any heat strike them.

For the Lamb who is in the center of the throne will shepherd them and lead them to springs of life-giving water, and God will wipe away every tear from their eyes." Rev.7.17
